

ORDINANCE

[To Amend City of Prattville Code of Ordinances Chapter 54. - Streets, Sidewalks and Other Public Places, Article I. - In General, Section 54-3. - Obstructions Generally.]

BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Prattville that the City of Prattville Code of Ordinances, Chapter 54, Article I, Section 54-3 is hereby amended to read as


follows:

Sec. 54-3. - Obstructions—Generally.

It shall be unlawful for any person to place goods, wares, merchandise, fruits, vegetables, boxes, barrels, containers, dispensers, recreational vehicles, truck tractors, utility trailers, travel trailers, trailers, semi trailers, self-propelled campers, flat bed tow trucks or any other obstruction of any kind in or upon any right-of-way, street, avenue, alley or sidewalk within the City. It shall likewise be unlawful for any person in charge of or occupying any property to permit goods, wares, merchandise, boxes, barrels, containers, dispensers, recreational vehicles, truck tractors, utility trailers, travel trailers, trailers, semi trailers, self-propelled campers, flat bed tow trucks or other obstructions to remain on the right-of-way, street, alley, avenue or sidewalk adjoining the property or in such person's charge or control, whether the same was placed thereon by such person or not.


THIS ordinance shall become effective upon its passage and execution as provided by law.


