16 17	SECTION 1. Chapter 2, Article III, "Boards, Committees, Commissions," of the Code of Ordinances is hereby amended as follows:
18 19	Sec. 2-46 Creation of Cemetery Advisory Board; Appointment; Terms; Meetings.
20 21 22 23 24 25 26 27 28 29 30 31 32 33	There is hereby created a Cemetery Advisory Board (Board) which shall consist of at least three (3) residents of the City, but up to a total of five (5) members. Five (5) members are preferable. If four (4) or five (5) members are serving on the Board, then one (1) member may be a non-resident of the City. Each member of the Board shall be appointed by the City Council to serve a term of one (1) year. The Board shall elect a chairman, who shall be a resident of the City, and appoint a secretary to keep minutes of each meeting. The minutes of each Board meeting shall be filed of record with the City Clerk. The Board shall meet no less than quarterly of each year. Notice of quarterly meetings shall be posted at City Hall and on the City's website at least ten calendar days before the meeting. Vacancies on the Board shall be filled by the City council. Special meetings may be called by City Council, City Manager or his/her designee, and/or the Chairman of the Board. Notice of special meetings shall be posted at City Hall and on the City's website at least seventy-two (72) hours before the date of the meeting. A quorum for the transaction of business shall consist of a majority of the members currently serving on the Board. All meetings shall be open to the public.

The Cemetery Advisory Board shall act purely in its capacity as an advisory board to the

City Council on issues relating to the City Cemetery, including, but not limited to, fees, charges, rules and regulations, and use of the real property consisting of the cemetery. The Board shall

40 also perform such other tasks as directed by City council. All decisions regarding the City 41 Cemetery rest solely with the City Council. 42 **SECTION 2. Severability.** If any portion of this Ordinance is declared invalid or unenforceable, 43 then to the extent it is possible to do so without destroying the overall intent and effect of this Ordinance, the portion deemed invalid or unenforceable shall be severed here from, and the 44 remainder of this Ordinance shall continue in full force and effect as if it were enacted without 45 46 including the portion found to be invalid or unenforceable. 47 **SECTION 3.** Conflicts. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby 48 repealed. 49 **SECTION 4.** Codification. It is the intent of the City Council of the City of Mascotte that the 50 provisions of this Ordinance shall be codified. The codifier is granted broad and liberal authority in renumbering and codifying the provision of this Ordinance; article and section numbers 51 52 assigned throughout are suggested by the City. 53 54 **SECTION 5.** Effective Date.
