

ORDINANCE NO. 1821

VILLAGE OF BARTONVILLE, ILLINOIS

AN ORDINANCE CREATING THE BARTONVILLE POLICE DEPARTMENT AND
ESTABLISHING CERTAIN REGULATIONS THERE TO
(REPEAL ORDINANCE NO. 1508)

WHEREAS, the Village of Bartonville is a home rule municipality in accordance with Section 6 of Article VII off the Constitution of the State of Illinois and as such, has the authority to create this Ordinance; and

WHEREAS, 65 ILCS 5/11-1-1 provides that the corporate authorities may pass and enforce all necessary police ordinances;

WHEREAS, 65 ILCS 5/11-1-2 provides that the corporate authorities may prescribe the duties and powers of all police officers;

WHEREAS, 65 LCS 5/10-2.1-17 provides that if the Chief of the Police Department is appointed in a manner provided by ordinance he may be removed or discharged by the appointing authority;

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF BARTONVILLE, ILLINOIS:

SECTION 1. There is hereby created the Police Department of the Village of Bartonville, Illinois.

SECTION 2, The Police Department of the Village of Bartonville shall enforce the ordinances of the Village of Bartonville, the laws and constitution of the State of Illinois, and the laws and Constitution of the United States of-America. To this end, it shall be the duty and power of all Police officers to:

- A. Preserve the public peace, prevent crime, detect and arrest offenders against the criminal laws and ordinances effective within the Village, suppress riots; mobs and insurrections, disperse unlawful or dangerous assemblages, protect the rights of all and preserve order at all elections and assemblages;
- B. Administer and enforce laws and ordinances to regulate, direct, control, and facilitate the movement of vehicular and pedestrian traffic and the use of streets by vehicles and persons, and to adhere to rules and regulations which shall facilitate the lawful goals of the Department;
- C. Remove all nuisances in public places, inspect and Observe all places of public amusement or assemblages and all places of business within the Village limits which require any State, County; or Village permit/license;
- D. Provide proper police response to calls for police service;
- E. Provide for the attendance of police officers or civilian employees in court as necessary for the prosecution and trial of persons charged with crimes and other violations of the law; and cooperate fully with the law enforcement and prosecuting authorities of Federal, State, County, and Municipal governments;

- F. Attain and retain maximum efficiency and effectiveness by policies and procedures designed to protect and serve the Village of Bartonville and to satisfy the afforested goals.

SECTION 3. There shall be no residency requirements imposed upon applicants for a position in the Bartonville Police Department or officers serving their probationary period.

SECTION 4. The Chief of Police of the Village of Bartonville shall be appointed by the President with the concurrence of the Board of Trustees. The Chief of Police may be appointed from any rank within the Department or from outside the Department.

SECTION 5. Ordinances No. 667, 1263, 1508 and all other ordinances or resolutions in conflict with this Ordinance are hereby repealed.

SECTION 6. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and publication as provided by law.
