

ORDINANCE NO. 2179

AN ORDINANCE REGULATING PUBLIC OFFENSES WITHIN THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE CITY OF FREDONIA, KANSAS; INCORPORATING BY REFERENCE THE "UNIFORM PUBLIC OFFENSE CODE FOR KANSAS CITIES," EDITION OF 2022, AND REPEALING ORDINANCE NUMBERS 2172.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF FREDONIA, KANSAS:

SECTION 1. INCORPORATING UNIFORM PUBLIC OFFENSE CODE. There is hereby incorporated by reference for the purpose of regulating public offenses within the corporate limits of the City of Fredonia, Kansas that certain code known as the "Uniform Public Offense Code," Edition of 2022, prepared and published in book form by the League of Kansas Municipalities, Topeka, Kansas. No fewer than three copies of said Uniform Public Offense Code shall be marked or stamped "Official Copy as Adopted by Ordinance No. 2172," and to which shall be attached a copy of this ordinance, and filed with the City Clerk to be open to inspection and available to the public at all reasonable hours.

SECTION 2. PENALTY FOR SCHEDULED FINES. The fine for violation of a public ordinance infraction or any public offense for which the municipal judge establishes a fine in a fine schedule shall not be less than \$25.00 nor more than \$2,500.00 plus court costs. A person tried and convicted for violation of a public ordinance infraction or other public offense for which a fine has been established in a schedule of fines shall pay a fine fixed by the court not to exceed \$2,500.00.

SECTION 3. REPEAL. Ordinance No. 2172 is repealed.

Section 4. EFFECTIVE DATE. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication in the official city newspaper.
