ORDINANCE NO. 2020-117-0

The provisions and sections of this Ordinance shall be deemed severable, and the invalidity of any portion of this Ordinance shall not affect the validity of the remainder.

All orders, resolutions, or ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed insofar as such conflict exists, and this Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its passage, approval, and publication, as required by law.

Sec. 117-5. - Posting handbills, other advertising.

- (a) It shall be unlawful for any person to place any handbill, poster, advertisement or notice of any kind, or cause the same to be placed on any curb, sidewalk or street, or upon any tree, lamppost, telephone pole, hydrant, bridge, pier, or upon any other structure within the public right-of-way in the city, except such notices as may be required by the laws of the state and/or this Code.
- (b) It shall be unlawful for any person to place any handbill, sign, poster, advertisement or notice of any kind, or cause the same to be placed upon any private structure unless the person is the owner, agent or lessee thereof, without the written consent of the owner, agent or lessee of the private structure.
- (c) When the handbill, sign, poster, advertising or notice of any kind shall be found placed in violation of the provisions of this section, it shall be prima facie evidence that it was placed in violation of this section by the person or business advertised thereon.
- (d) Notwithstanding the forgoing, the Rockford Mass Transit District (RMTD) shall be allowed to place shelter advertising in bus shelters owned by the RMTD, which will be limited to one advertisement per shelter of twenty-one (21) square feet. Any framing mechanism to hold the advertising shall match the material and color of the shelter structure, and the advertising shall be placed on the opposite side of the shelter from oncoming traffic. The advertisement is permitted to be viewable from both the inside and outside of the shelter.
