

Sec. 19-13. – Disorderly Conduct

(a) Definitions.

(2) *Drug paraphernalia* means all equipment, products and materials of any kind, which are intended, marketed, or likely to be used as an accessory item to the personal use or storage of a controlled substance as defined under the Illinois Controlled Substances Act,

(3) *Cannabis paraphernalia* means all equipment, products and materials of any kind, which are intended, marketed, or likely to be used as an accessory item to the personal use or storage of cannabis.

(4) *Public Place* means any place where a person could reasonably be expected to be observed by others. "Public place" includes all parts of buildings owned in whole or in part, or leased, by the State or a unit of local government. "Public place" includes all areas in a park, recreation area, wildlife area, or playground owned in whole or in part, leased, or managed by the State or a unit of local government. "Public place" does not include a private residence unless the private residence is used to provide licensed child care, foster care, or other similar social service care on the premises. (State Law Reference: 410 ILCS 705/10-35)

(b) A person commits disorderly conduct when he:

(34) Possesses any drug paraphernalia; or is under the age of 21 and possesses cannabis paraphernalia.

(35) Possesses cannabis:

- a) Under the age of 21;
- b) On a school bus;
- c) On the grounds of any preschool or primary or secondary school, unless permitted for a qualifying patient or caregiver pursuant to the Compassionate Use of Medical Cannabis Program Act;
- d) In a vehicle not open to the public unless the cannabis is in a reasonably secured, sealed container and reasonably inaccessible while the vehicle is moving; or
- e) In a private residence that is used at any time to provide licensed child care or other similar social service care on the premises;

Or smokes cannabis in the following places:

- f) In any motor vehicle;
- g) In any public place;
- h) Knowingly in close physical proximity to anyone under 21 years of age who is not a registered medical cannabis patient under the Compassionate Use of Medical Cannabis Program Act;

(c) *Penalties.*

(4) A person found to be liable for a violation of this section shall be fined no less than \$150.00.
