**RESOLUTION NUMBER 100-2021**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF STUART, FLORIDA ADOPTING APPENDIX “A” BY AMENDING CHAPTER 12, CHAPTER 22, CHAPTER 32, CHAPTER 34, AND CHAPTER 42 OF THE CITY’S CODE OF ORDINANCES, AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.**

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to various provisions of the City Code, the City Commission has determined that certain rates, fess, and charges for municipal services be amended.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF STUART, FLORIDA that:**

**SECTION 1:** The application types, fees, rates, and charges in Chapter 12 of Appendix “A” are amended to align with area towing and storage fees.

**SECTION 2:** The application types, fees, rates, and charges in Chapter 22 of Appendix “A” are amended to align with area fees and rates, specifically Martin County.

**SECTION 3:** The application types, fees, rates, and charges in Chapter 32 of Appendix “A” are amended to comply with indexing as directed by previous commission resolution.

**SECTION 4:** The fees, rates, and charges in Chapter 34 for solid waste collection are adjusted in accordance with the Water, Wastewater, and Sanitation Rate Study adopted on August 14, 2017.

**SECTION 5:** The fees, rates, and charges in Chapter 42 for water and wastewater are adjusted in accordance the Florida Public Service Commission Price Index published on February 16, 2021 and with the adopted Water, Wastewater, and Sanitation Rate Study dated August 14, 2017 are hereby adopted for use by the City in conjunction with the provision of utilities services by the City.

**SECTION 6:** The City Commission retains jurisdiction over the rate schedule and any administrative costs, which may be later amended from time to time, by Resolution.

**SECTION 7:** This resolution shall take effect immediately upon adoption.
