

ORDINANCE 20-1245

AN ORDINANCE REGULATING THE SPEED ON STATE MAINTAINED HIGHWAYS IN THE CITY OF LUMBERTON, HARDIN COUNTY, TEXAS PROVIDING A PENALTY AND REPEALING ALL OTHER ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT THEREWITH.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF LUMBERTON, HARDIN COUNTY, TEXAS.

SECTION I – REGULATING SPEED ON STATE MAINTAINED HIGHWAYS:

The maximum legal speed limits of all vehicles, in the city limits of Lumberton on the following highways shall be as set forth in each zone as shown on the Attached Speed Zone Strip Map, based on eighty-five percentile speed, and traffic and engineering investigations made by the Texas Department of Transportation. Said Speed Zone Strip Map is hereby made a part of this Ordinance and is as follows:

FM 421 (US Hwy 69 at mile point 13.225 to US Hwy 96 at mile point 14.115)	May 14, 2020

SECTION II – PENALTY

Any person who violates any provision of this Ordinance or who shall neglect to comply with the terms hereof shall be deemed guilty of a Class C Misdemeanor, and upon conviction, shall be fined in the amount prescribed by State Law and the violation of the posted maximum speed in each zone of the Speed Zone Strip Map and each time each maximum speed in each zone is violated, constitutes a separate offense.

SECTION III – REPEALING CLAUSE

Any and all Ordinances of the City of Lumberton, Texas in conflict with any of the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby expressly repealed.
