

On motion of **Ms. Lee-Sheng**, seconded by **Mr. Capella**, the following ordinance was offered:

SUMMARY NO. 23197 ORDINANCE NO. 23978

An ordinance amending Section 20-62 of the Jefferson Parish Code of Ordinances relative to houses declared to be a public nuisance and to persons occupying or visiting such houses; and otherwise providing with respect thereto.

THE JEFFERSON PARISH COUNCIL HEREBY ORDAINS:

SECTION 1. That Section 20-62 of the Jefferson Parish Code of Ordinances is hereby amended to read as follows:

Sec. 20-62. Houses in which certain illegal acts are conducted declared to be public nuisances; person occupying.

Whenever one or more acts of prostitution or the solicitation of prostitution, or the manufacture, sale or distribution of controlled dangerous substances, as those illegal acts are defined and prohibited under applicable state and parish laws, are committed within the premises of any house or other structure in Jefferson Parish, said house or other structure shall be declared to be a public nuisance, and any person occupying or visiting such house or other structure shall be guilty of a misdemeanor.

The ordinance was declared to be adopted on this 16th day of March, 2011, and shall become effective as follows: if signed forthwith by the Parish President, ten (10) days after adoption; thereafter, upon the signature by the Parish President, or, if not signed by the Parish President, upon expiration of the time for ordinances to be considered finally adopted without the signature of the Parish President, as provided in Section 2.07 of the Charter. If vetoed by the Parish President and subsequently approved by the Council, this ordinance shall become effective on the day of such approval
