RESOLUTION

**FOR THE PURPOSE OF AMENDING CHAPTER 162 OF
THE CODE OF ST. MARY'S COUNTY, MARYLAND, TO ADD AN ALTERNATE
MEMBER TO THE HISTORIC PRESERVATION COMMISSION**

WHEREAS, by Resolution No. 75-50, codified as Chapter 162 of the Code of St. Mary's County, Maryland, the Board of County Commissioners for St. Mary's County created the St. Mary's County Historic District Commission pursuant to art. 66B, §8.01 *et seq.* of the *Annotated Code of Maryland*; and

WHEREAS, by Resolution No. 2002-37, the Board of County Commissioners for St. Mary's County changed the name of the St. Mary's County Historic District Commission to "St. Mary's County Historic Preservation Commission" pursuant to art. 66B, §8.03(a) of the *Annotated Code of Maryland*; and

WHEREAS, by Resolution 2011-22, the Board of County Commissioners for St. Mary's County amended Chapter 162 of the Code of St. Mary's County, Maryland and restated the establishment of the Historic Preservation Commission.

WHEREAS, §8-202(e)(1-2) of the *Land Use Article* of the *Annotated Code of Maryland*; allows each local jurisdiction to designate one alternate member for the commission who may sit on the commission when any other member of the commission is absent and that when the alternate member is absent the local jurisdiction may designate a temporary alternate;

WHEREAS, the Commissioners of St. Mary's County find that is in the best interest of the citizens of St. Mary's County to amend Ch. 162 of the Code of St. Mary's County, Maryland to add an alternate member to the St. Mary's County Historic Preservation Commission.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that Chapter 162 of the Code of St. Mary's County, Maryland, is amended to read as follow:

HISTORIC PRESERVATION COMMISSION

Sec. 162-1. Establishment.

There is hereby established the St. Mary's County Historic Preservation Commission.

Sec. 162-2. Membership.

The St. Mary's County Historic District Commission shall have seven (7) members and one alternate member, all of whom shall qualify for membership by interest, training or background, or a combination thereof.

Sec. 162-3. Terms.

Members shall be appointed for staggered terms. Members on the effective date of this resolution shall continue as members during the term for which the member was appointed.

Sec. 162-4. Support.

The Department of Land Use and Growth Management shall provide necessary staff support to the St. Mary's County Historic Preservation Commission.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that this Resolution shall be effective at the date written below.
