AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWN OF MOUNT OLIVE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS
OF THE TOWN OF MOUNT OLIVE, NORTH CAROLINA
AMENDING CHAPTER 59 OF THE ZONING CODE
OF THE TOWN OF MOUNT OLIVE, NORTH CAROLINA
SECTION 59.1 DEFINITIONS IS AMENDED BY ADDING INDOOR RECREATION FACILITY
SECTIONS 59-121(a) AND 59-123 (a) ARE AMENDED BY ADDING INDOOR RECREATIONAL FACILITY

The Town of Mount Olive Board of Commissioners of the Town of Mount Olive, North Carolina, doth ordain:

1. That the Code of Ordinance, Town of Mount Olive, North Carolina is amended by revising Chapter 59 Zoning Code, Section 59-1 Definitions. The revised section 59-1 reads as follows:

Indoor Recreational Facility means a building or group of buildings, providing amusement activities completely enclosed within the building or buildings where only non-alcoholic beverages are sold and consumed. Indoor amusement activities may include arcades, indoor arenas, batting cages, bowling alleys, miniature golf courses, play court, roller or ice skating, or similar indoor uses, which may be operated as non-profit or for profit. Indoor firing/shooting ranges are prohibited.

2. That the Code of Ordinance, Town of Mount Olive, North Carolina is amended by revising Chapter 59 Zoning Code, Sections 59-121(a) and 59-123 (a). The revised sections read as follows:

*Section 59-121 (a) 66 Indoor Recreational Facility
Section 59-123 (a) 22 Indoor Recreational Facility.*

3. If this ordinance or the application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of the ordinance which can be given separate effect and to that end the provisions of this ordinance are declared to be severable.

4. Any ordinance or any part of the ordinance in conflict with this ordinance, to the extent of such conflict, is hereby repealed.

5. This ordinance is adopted in the interest of public health, safety and general welfare of the inhabitants of the Town of Mount Olive, North Carolina, and shall be in full force and effect from and after its adoption.
