ORDINANCE NO. 1472-18

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF MILTON AMENDING THE CHARTER TO PROVIDE FOR A NEW DEADLINE FOR THE COUNCIL TO ACT TO COMPLETE THE PROCEDURE FOR FILLING A VACANCY, PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY, REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES OR PORTIONS OF ORDINANCES INCONSISTENT HEREWITH, AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Milton in evaluating the logistics of filling a vacancy deems it appropriate to amend the Charter of the City of Milton by extending the deadline to appoint a replacement from thirty days to sixty days to provide the City Council with sufficient time to review interested applicants and to ensure sufficient notice to the public to promote its participation in the process; and

WHEREAS, the City Council wishes to implement this change to the Charter if approved by the voters of the City of Milton in the November 2018 election; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Milton is permitted by law to amend the Charter as proposed herein subject to approval by a majority of the voters of the City of Milton, in which event, the ordinance will become effective upon approval by the electorate;

NOW THEREFORE THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MILTON, FLORIDA, PROPOSES TO THE VOTERS OF THE CITY OF MILTON THAT THE CHARTER OF THE CITY OF MILTON BE AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS: [the underlined portion below is to be added to the Charter and the strikethrough language is to be deleted upon approval by a majority of the electorate]:

SECTION 1: TIME WITHIN WHICH THE CITY COUNCIL MUST ACT TO APPOINT A SUCCESSOR TO A VACANT OFFICE

AMENDING ARTICLE V, SECTION 5-6 AS FOLLOWS:

An elected officer who ceases to possess any of the qualifications for the office required under this Charter shall forthwith forfeit the office. Additional grounds for forfeiture of the elective office shall be as provided in state law. Any vacancy in the elective office shall be filled by appointment until the next election by a majority vote of all the city council members in office at the time of the vacancy. If the vacancy is not filled within 30 60 days after it shall have occurred, the appointment to fill the vacancy until the next election shall be made by the governor of the State of Florida.

SECTION 2: SEVERABILITY

If any section, sentence, clause or phrase or this Ordinance is held to be invalid or unconstitutional by any Court of competent jurisdiction, then said holding shall in no way affect the validity of the remaining portions of this Ordinance.

SECTION 3: REPEALER

All ordinance and parts of ordinances in conflict with this ordinance are hereby repealed.

SECTION 4: EFFECTIVE DATE

This Ordinance shall be effective upon certification of the results of the November 2018 election if a majority of the voters of the City of Milton approve of this amendment to the Charter of the City of Milton.
