

ORDINANCE O-2018-57

A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 3.04.885 OF THE LONGMONT  
MUNICIPAL CODE, ADOPTING AMENDED AND RESTATED CITY OF LONGMONT  
“OLD HIRE” FIREFIGHTERS’ PENSION PLAN

THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LONGMONT, COLORADO, ORDAINS:

Section 1

The Council finds:

Pursuant to Sections 4.9 and 4.10 of the Home Rule Charter, the Longmont City Council has, by Section 3.04.885 of the Longmont Municipal Code, previously adopted certain pension plans and trust agreements for the City employees promulgated by the City and its pension attorneys; and

The City and its pension attorneys have amended The City of Longmont “Old Hire” Firefighters’ Pension Plan after the Council last adopted it; and

The Council has determined to adopt the amendments to The City of Longmont “Old Hire” Firefighters’ Pension Plan now before the Council.

Section 2

In this Ordinance, ellipses indicate material not reproduced as the Council intends to leave that material in effect as it now reads.

Section 3

The Council approves and authorizes execution of the amendment of the City of Longmont “Old Hire” Firefighters’ Pension Plan as described herein.

1    Section 4

2           Effective January 1, 2019, the Council amends Article V of the City of Longmont “Old  
3   Hire” Firefighters’ Pension Plan by adding italicized material to read as follows:

4                                   ARTICLE V

5                                   Pension Benefits

6           *Section 10. Increase to Retirees and Beneficiaries Effective January 1, 2019:*  
7           *Effective January 1, 2019, benefits in pay status to retirees and surviving spouses*  
8           *or dependent parents shall be increased. The increase shall be equal to 1% of the*  
9           *benefit amount in effect on January 1, 2018, for each full year that has passed since*  
10          *January 1, 2014, or since the participant retired, whichever is later, until January*  
11          *1, 2019.*

12   Section 5

13          The Council amends paragraph F of section 3.04.885 of the Longmont Municipal Code,  
14   by adding italicized material, to read as follows:

15          3.04.885 Pension plans adopted by reference.

16          Under Sections 4.9 and 4.10 of the Home Rule Charter, the city council adopts the  
17   following, as promulgated by the City of Longmont and its pension attorneys:

19          F.     The City of Longmont “Old Hire” Police Officers’ Pension Plan (as  
20          amended and restated effective January 1, 1992, and as amended and restated  
21          effective January 1, 2001, and as amended and restated effective January 1, 2002,  
22          and as amended effective March 28, 2005, and as amended effective January 1,  
23          2008); and as amended effective January 1, 2012; and as amended effective  
24          January 1, 2013; and as amended and restated effective January 1, 2014 by

Ordinance 2014-03 and again restated effective January 1, 2014 by Ordinance  
2015-01; and *as amended and restated effective January 1, 2019 by Ordinance O-*  
*2018-[insert ordinance number]; and*

Section 6

To the extent only that they conflict with this ordinance, the Council repeals any  
conflicting ordinances or parts of ordinances. The provisions of this ordinance are severable, and  
invalidity of any part shall not affect the validity or effectiveness of the rest of this ordinance.
