

ORDINANCE NO. 22-OR804-1

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
OCEANSIDE AMENDING ARTICLE X OF OCEANSIDE
TRAFFIC CODE AND AMENDING CHAPTER 29A OF THE
OCEANSIDE CITY CODE

WHEREAS, as a result of staff's review of the Oceanside Traffic Code ("OTC"), it has been determined that certain sections should be modified in order to have timed parking spaces enforced on Sundays and Holidays; and

WHEREAS, a thorough review of Chapter 29A as well as other Harbor District ordinances, resolutions, regulations and traffic codes has been completed in order to recommend changes to the Chapter; and

WHEREAS, Chapter 29A of the Oceanside City Code sets forth regulations for the Oceanside Small Craft Harbor; and

WHEREAS, as a result of staff's review of the Oceanside City Code it has been determined that certain sections should be modified to provide provisions where and when oversized vehicles and unattached trailers can park within the Harbor District parking lot #1 through lot #5; and

WHEREAS, it is the intent of the City to repeal any and all other ordinances, resolutions, regulations and traffic codes in conflict with this Ordinance;

NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Oceanside does ordain as follows:

SECTION 1.

Certain Sections of Article X of the Oceanside Traffic Code are hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 10.21 Time-limited zones to be established by the Public Works Director.

All time-limited parking zones as provided by section 10.22 through 10.26 shall be established and designated by the Public Works Director. For the purposes of section 10.22 through 10.26, Harbor District shall mean the following area: Any street or parking lot as shown on Exhibit 'A' – "Harbor District."

Section 10.22 Fifteen-minute parking.

When authorized signs or curb markings have been determined by the city traffic engineer to be necessary and are in place giving notice thereof, no operator of any

vehicle shall stop, stand or park said vehicle between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 6:00 p.m. of any day, except Sundays and Holidays, for a period of time longer than fifteen (15) minutes. In the Harbor District, the foregoing exception for Sundays and Holidays shall not apply.

Section 10.23 Thirty-minute parking.

When authorized signs or curb markings have been determined by the city traffic engineer to be necessary and are in place giving notice thereof, no operator of any vehicle shall stop, stand or park said vehicle between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 6:00 p.m. of any day, except Sundays and Holidays, for a period of time longer than thirty (30) minutes. In the Harbor District, the foregoing exception for Sundays and Holidays shall not apply.

Section 10.24 One-hour parking.

When authorized signs or curb markings have been determined by the city traffic engineer to be necessary and are in place giving notice thereof, no operator of any vehicle shall stop, stand or park said vehicle between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 6:00 p.m. of any day, except Sundays and Holidays, for a period of time longer than one (1) hour. In the Harbor District, the foregoing exception for Sundays and Holidays shall not apply.

Section 10.25 Two-hour parking.

When authorized signs or curb markings have been determined by the city traffic engineer to be necessary and are in place giving notice thereof, no operator of any vehicle shall stop, stand or park said vehicle between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 6:00 p.m. of any day, except Sundays and Holidays, for a period of time longer than two (2) hours. In the Harbor District, the foregoing exception for Sundays and Holidays shall not apply.

SECTION 2.

Certain sections of Article V of Chapter 29A of the City Code are hereby amended to read as follows:

1 **Section 29A.47. References to numbered parking lots, streets, Harbor District and beach**
2 **area.**

- 3 a) Numbered parking lots, Harbor District or streets as used in this article shall be as
4 shown on Exhibit “A” – “Harbor District”.
- 5 b) Beach area as used in this article shall mean all that land lying westerly of Pacific
6 Street, Parking Lot 11A, Parking Lot 11B and Lot 12 as such street, and parking lots
7 are shown on Exhibit “A” – “Harbor District”, extending to mean low tide.

8 **Section 29A.50. Parking boat trailers.**

- 9 a) No vehicles other than a boat trailer or with a boat trailer attached shall park in the
10 dedicated parking spaced for said vehicles in Parking Lot 1 and Parking lot 11A.
- 11 b) No single vehicle (vehicle without a boat trailer attached) shall be parked in any of
12 the parking stalls, except those specifically designated for single vehicle parking,
13 numbered or unnumbered, in Parking Lot 1, Parking Lot 11A.

14 **Section 29A.51. Prohibited parking of vehicles other than automobiles.**

- 15 a) No oversized vehicle or unattached trailer (as defined in Section 10.28.1 of the
16 Oceanside Traffic Code) shall be parked in the Harbor Drive North, except in the
17 designated area.
- 18 b) No person shall park or allow to be parked on Harbor Drive North an oversized
19 vehicle or unattached trailer between the hours of 10:00 p.m. and 4 a.m. daily.
- 20 c) Slip permittees and harbor commercial lessees may obtain a special permit to park an
21 oversized vehicle overnight in these restricted zones for a limited time, not to exceed
22 seventy-two (72) hours at the discretion of Harbor administration.

23 **Section 29A.52. Penalties; continuing violations.**

24 This section is hereby deleted its entirety.

25 **SECTION 3.** Severability. If any section, sentence, clause or phrase of this Ordinance
26 is for any reason held to be invalid or unconstitutional by a decision of any court of competent
27 jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this
28 Ordinance. The City Council hereby declares that it would have passed this Ordinance and
adopted this Ordinance and each section, sentence, clause or phrase thereof, irrespective of the

fact that any one or more sections, subsections, sentences, clauses or phrases be declared invalid or unconstitutional.

SECTION 4. The City Clerk of the City of Oceanside is hereby directed to publish this ordinance, or the title hereof as a summary, pursuant to state statute, once within fifteen (15) days after its passage in the San Diego Union Tribune, North County edition, a newspaper of general circulation published in the City of Oceanside.

SECTION 5. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force on the thirtieth (30th) day from and after its final passage.
