**AN ORDINANCE OF THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF "CENTERVILLE" GEORGIA AMENDING CITY ORDINANCE, CHAPTER 18 Emergency Management and Services, Article I Emergency Management, Section 18-2 Emergency management response powers, Subsection (4) Effect of declaration of local emergency, (d) additional emergency powers, sub-subsection (b), PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE, AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.**

**WHEREAS**, the Mayor and Council of the City of Centerville may, as allowed by the Georgia Constitution and the Laws of the State of Georgia and as authorized by City Code Section 1-5(b) "Amendments to Code", amend the Centerville Code of Ordinances; then

**THEREFORE**, be it ordained that the current CHAPTER 18 Emergency Management and Services, Article I Emergency Management, Section 18-2 Emergency management response powers, Subsection (4) Effect of declaration of local emergency, (d) additional emergency powers, sub subsection (b), shall be amended by striking the word "firearms" and shall now read as follows:

*To suspend or limit the sale, dispensing or transportation of alcoholic beverages, ~~firearms~~, explosives and flammable liquids and substances.*

**CONFLICTING ORDINANCES:** In the event that any ordinance, or any part thereof, of the City of "Centerville", Georgia is in conflict herewith, this ordinance shall have preference.

**SEVERABILITY:** If any provisions of this ordinance be held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect other provisions which can be given effect without the invalid provision, and to this end the provisions of this ordinance are declared to be severable.

**SO ORDAINED**, and effective this 18 day of November, 2014, by vote of the Governing Authority at a regular, open meeting of the Mayor and Council of Centerville with a quorum being present at the meeting.

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF "CENTERVILLE" GEORGIA  
ADDING CITY ORDINANCE SECTION 16-62 "Failure to appear and warrant fees", PROVIDING  
AN EFFECTIVE DATE, AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.**

**WHEREAS**, the Mayor and Council of the City of Centerville, as provided for by the laws of the State of Georgia and as authorized by City Charter, Section 9, constitute the legislative department of the City's government; and

**WHEREAS**, the Mayor and Council, as the City's legislative body and in accordance with the City Charter, have full power and authority over all matters related to the security, health, and well-being of the citizens of Centerville; then

**THEREFORE**, be it ordained that City Ordinance Section 16-62 is hereby added to the Centerville Code of Ordinances as follows:

Sec. 16-62. Failure to Appear and Warrant fees.





In addition to state mandated court surcharges and fees and municipal court costs, anyone who fails to appear in municipal court on arraignment or trial day shall pay a fee of \$50.00 in addition to any other fines and fees associated with the case. If a warrant has been issued as a result of failure to appear on arraignment or trial day, an additional \$100.00 fee shall apply in addition to any other fines and fees associated with the case.

**CONFLICTING ORDINANCES:** In the event that any ordinance, or any part thereof, of the City of "Centerville", Georgia is in conflict herewith, this ordinance shall have preference.

**SEVERABILITY:** If any provisions of this ordinance be held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect other provisions which can be given effect without the invalid provision, and to this end the provisions of this ordinance are declared to be severable.

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF "CENTERVILLE" GEORGIA  
AMENDING CITY ORDINANCE Chapter 66, Article VIII, Section 66-217 "Keeping of fowl"  
PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE, AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.**

**WHEREAS**, the Mayor and Council of the City of Centerville, as provided for by the laws of the State of Georgia and as authorized by City Charter, Section 9, constitute the legislative department of the City's government; and

**WHEREAS**, the Mayor and Council, as the City's legislative body and in accordance with the City Charter, have full power and authority over all matters related to the security, health, and well-being of the citizens of Centerville; and

**WHEREAS**, the initial permitting and renewal procedures for the keeping of urban chickens involves significant staff time and city resources; then

**THEREFORE**, be it ordained that City Ordinance Chapter 66, Article VIII, Sections 66-217(7)(a) & (d) are hereby amended as follows:

(7) Annual residential chicken permit required. No person shall keep any chickens nor construct any coop or run as defined by this Section without first obtaining an annual residential chicken permit hereunder.

(a) Fee. An application fee of ~~\$25.00~~ \$50.00 shall be paid to the City at the time the application is filed.

(d) Application approved annually. Approval of applications under this Section shall be for one calendar year (January 1<sup>st</sup> through December 31<sup>st</sup>). Renewal application must be submitted prior to January 31<sup>st</sup> of each subsequent calendar year. Applications that show no changes from the initial approval and have no history of violations of this Section shall be approved for the new calendar year. Any changes to the chicken coop



and run shall be shown on the renewal application and shall be subject to inspection prior to approval of the renewal application. Any convictions of a violation of this Section may result in revocation of a current approved application or non-renewal of a subsequent application. *The annual renewal fee shall be \$50.00.*

**CONFLICTING ORDINANCES:** In the event that any ordinance, or any part thereof, of the City of "Centerville", Georgia is in conflict herewith, this ordinance shall have preference.

**EFFECTIVE DATE:** This amendment shall be effective immediately.

**SEVERABILITY:** If any provisions of this ordinance be held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect other provisions which can be given effect without the invalid provision, and to this end the provisions of this ordinance are declared to be severable.
