

ORDINANCE #1663

ENACTED 9/19/11  
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AMENDMENT TO THE NEW HAVEN CODE OF GENERAL ORDINANCES  
REGARDING PRORATING OF RESIDENTIAL PARKING PERMITS.

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WHEREAS: New or updated residential parking zones are frequently implemented in residential areas all across the city; and

WHEREAS: whenever a new or updated residential parking zone goes into effect, residents must now purchase parking permits for the full permit year which runs from October 1 through September 30 of the following year; and

WHEREAS: it is only fair and appropriate that residents in newly created or updated residential parking zones should only have to pay that portion of the annual permit fee which covers the months remaining in the permit year.

BE IT ORDAINED that the New Haven Code of General Ordinances is amended so that:

First, existing Sec. 29-55. - Residential Parking, Subsection (e) shall be deleted;

Second, the new Sec. 29-55 Subsection (e) shall be substituted in its place, as follows:

- (e) The director of traffic and parking shall establish a fee schedule for the issuance of permits issued pursuant to this section. The fee schedule is included in section 17-20 of this Code. All permits shall be issued on an annual basis to run from October 1 until September 30 of the following year. In the first year of the implementation of a new or updated residential parking zone, all initial permits issued to residents shall be prorated in one-twelfth increments for each month left in the permit year.
