ORDINANCE NO. 703-18-2016-B

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CONVERSE, TEXAS, AMENDING CODE OF ORDINANCES, CITY OF CONVERSE, TEXAS, CHAPTER 18, “ENVIRONMENTAL”, ARTICLE IV. “JUNK VEHICLES” AND PROVIDING A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE; AND ESTABLISHING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City of Converse, Texas has established a Code of Ordinances, published by Municipal Corporation; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Converse, Texas desires to amend its Code of Ordinances in a manner consistent with the intent of the City Council of the City of Converse, Texas:

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CONVERSE, TEXAS;

SECTION- I: That the Code of Ordinances, City of Converse, Texas, Chapter 18, “Environmental”, Article IV “Junk Vehicles” Section 18-97. are hereby amended to read as follows:

As used in this article, the term "junked vehicle" means a vehicle that:

- (1) is self-propelled; and displays an expired license plate or does not display a license plate; and
- (2) Is:
 - a. Wrecked, dismantled or partially dismantled, or discarded; or
 - b. Inoperable and has remained inoperable for more than:
 1. 72 consecutive hours, if the vehicle is on public property; or
 - 30 consecutive days, if the vehicle is on private property

SECTION II- SEVERABILITY: If any section, subsection, paragraph, or sentence, clause, phrase, or word in this Ordinance, or application thereof, to any person or circumstance is held invalid such holding shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of the same and the City Council hereby declares it would have passed such remaining portions despite such invalidity.

SECTION III- SUPERSESION: All provisions of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Converse not herein amended or repealed shall remain in full force and effect.

All Ordinances or parts thereof in conflict herewith are repealed to the extent of such conflict only.

SECTION IV- EFFECTIVE DATE: This Ordinance shall become effective upon the publication in the newspaper as required by the Charter of the City of Converse, Texas. The date of such publication is expected to be the _____, day of _____, 2016.
