AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ATHENS CITY CODE, TITLE 7, CHAPTER 7.05  
PARKING REGULATIONS, SECTION 7.05.03.1, RESIDENTIAL PARKING PERMIT.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ATHENS, OHIO:

SECTION I: Athens City Code Title 7, Chapter 7.05, Parking Regulations,  
Section 7.05.03.1, Residential Parking Permit, is hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 7.05.03.1. Residential Parking Permit.

- (A) ~~The following streets shall be designated as 72-hour parking by permit only:  
Brown, Central, Elizabeth, First, Hanlin, Maple, Pratt, Shafer, Smith, West Hills  
and West Washington, Columbia, Franklin, Evans, Grosvenor, Highland, Mound,  
North Congress, and Spring.~~
  - (B) **(A) FOR STREETS WITH ON-STREET PARKING**, One permit per street  
address may be issued for a residence having only one or no off-street parking  
space available.
  - (C) **(B)** Vehicles parking in the restricted 72-hour parking zone, not displaying a valid  
permit, will be subject to Athens City Code 7.05.03, Continuous Parking in Same  
Location.
  - (D) **(C)** The Service-Safety Director or his/her designee shall accept and review all  
applications for a **72-HOUR** residential parking permit. The application must  
include vehicle registration, proof of residence on an authorized street, and a valid  
drivers' license, along with the annual application fee of \$35.00. Intentional  
misrepresentation on the permit application will result in permit denial or retraction  
of permit. Loss of permit will require reapplication, plus application fee. No permit  
will be issued if the applicant owes any outstanding obligations to the city.
  - (E) **(D)** Residential parking permits shall be displayed in a manner determined by the  
Service-Safety Director or his/her designee. Said permit does not guarantee a  
parking space, is valid only on street of residence, is not transferrable, and does  
not exempt the resident from other City of Athens parking regulations or code  
restrictions, except under Athens City Code Section 7.05.03, Continuous Parking  
in Same Location.

Permit duplication or fabrication will result in original applicant's loss of permit.


SECTION II: This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect at the earliest moment permitted by law upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
