#### **ORDINANCE NO. 23-23**

# AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 10 OF THE CITY OF ROGERS CODE OF ORDINANCES; PROVIDING FOR THE EMERGENCY CLAUSE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

**WHEREAS,** the Rogers City Council finds it to be in the best interest of the City to update the provisions governing buildings and buildings regulations found in Chapter 10 of its Code of Ordinances.

## NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ROGERS, ARKANSAS THAT:

<u>Section 1</u>: Chapter 10, Article II, Sec. 10-36 of the City of Rogers, Code of Ordinances is hereby deleted and the Municode Corporation is hereby instructed to delete that section;

<u>Section 2</u>: Chapter 10 of the City of Rogers, Code of Ordinances is amended to read as shown in the attached Exhibit "A" and the Municode Corporation is hereby instructed to make those revisions:

<u>Section 3: Emergency Clause:</u> The need to amend said City Code chapter is immediate in order to protect the public peace, health, safety, and welfare. An emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from the date of passage and approval;

<u>Section 4: Severability Provision:</u> If any part of this Ordinance is held invalid, the remainder of this Ordinance shall continue in effect as if such invalid portion never existed; and

<u>Section 5: Repeal of Conflicting Provisions:</u> All Ordinances, Resolutions, or Orders of the City Council, or parts of the same, in conflict with this Ordinance are repealed to the extent of such conflict.

### Chapter 10 BUILDINGS AND BUILDING REGULATIONS<sup>1</sup>

#### ARTICLE I. IN GENERAL

#### Sec. 10-2. Numbering of buildings.

- (a) Each property containing a principal building, structure or residence within the corporate limits of the city shall bear numerals indicating the street number for each principal building, structure, or residence visible from the street upon which the property fronts. The numerals shall be posted in such a manner as to be visible from a distance of not less than 100 feet. (See Sec. 20-144, F505.1)
- (b) It shall be the duty of the owner of each principal building, structure, or residence to post numerals indicating the street number on his property.
- (c) Noncompliance with section 10-2 is a violation of the City Code.

There is hereby adopted by reference, as fully as though set out herein verbatim, that certain published code known as the International Building Code, 2012 Edition most recently adopted within the Arkansas Fire Prevention Code, complete with appendices B, C, D, E, F, G, H, and I, and K, including any accumulative supplements, also including state reference codes and/or standards as and when adopted and approved by the Arkansas State Fire Marshal, three copies one copy of which are is on file in the office of the Rogers Clerk-Treasurer.
