

## RESOLUTION NUMBER 2021-12

### A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF COLLINSVILLE, OKLAHOMA ESTABLISHING RATES AND CHARGES FOR ELECTRIC SERVICES PROVIDED BY THE CITY OF COLLINSVILLE MUNICIPAL AUTHORITY:

**WHEREAS**, the City of Collinsville, Oklahoma, has an electric service provided by the Collinsville Municipal Authority for the benefit of the citizens within the Collinsville area; and

**WHEREAS** the cost of operating a municipal electric service continues to rise with the increase in the cost of power, fuel, personnel, training and services; and

**WHEREAS** the Collinsville Municipal Code provides that the Board of Commissioners from time to time by ordinance or resolution shall have the power to establish rates and charges for utility services; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Commission of the City of Collinsville has determined that an adjustment in the electric rates is necessary to continue providing electric services;

**NOW, THEREFORE**, be it resolved by the City Commission of the City of Collinsville that the following charges and rates are established for users of the Collinsville Municipal Electric Service to take effect on the November 2021 usage; November 2023 usage and November 2025 usage, and that the following charges are hereby approved:


