

RESOLUTION NO. 16-25

A RESOLUTION AMENDING APPENDIX A, SCHEDULE OF FEES AND CHARGES, LAWTON CITY CODE, 2015, AS AMENDED, BY ADDING AN ANIMAL ADMINISTRATIVE PROCESSING FEE AND INCREASING, REDUCING, AND ELIMINATING OTHER ANIMAL RELATED FEES, AND ESTABLISHING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, Section 1-2-205, Chapter 1, Lawton City Code, 2015, provides that fees and charges shall be set by resolution; and

WHEREAS, the City of Lawton Animal Welfare Division has proposed changes to various fees contained in Appendix A-5, Schedule of Fees and Charges (Animals) as they relate to adoptions, impoundment, trapping, redemption, and licensing of animals cared for and processed through the Animal Welfare Division.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and Council of the City of Lawton, Oklahoma that:

Section 1. APPENDIX A, Schedule of Fees and Charges, Lawton City Code, 2015, be amended as set out in the attached Exhibit "A", as approved by the Council.

Section 2. EFFECTIVE DATE. The provisions of this resolution shall be in full force and effect on **April 25, 2016**.
