

ORDINANCE NO. 1672

AN ORDINANCE REGULATING UNIFORM PUBLIC OFFENSES CODE WITHIN THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE CITY OF OSAGE CITY, KANSAS; INCORPORATING BY REFERENCE THE “UNIFORM PUBLIC OFFENSE CODE FOR KANSAS CITIES”, 38th EDITION; PROVIDING CERTAIN PENALTIES AND REPEALING ORDINANCE NUMER 1663.

BE IT ORDNANIED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF OSAGE CITY, KANSAS:

SECTION 1: INCORPORATING UNIFORM PUBLIC OFFENCES CODE. There is hereby incorporated by reference for the purpose of regulating public offences known as the “Uniform Public Offense Code”, 38th Edition, prepared and published in book form by the League of Kansas Municipalities, Topeka, Kansas, save and except the following sections which are hereby amended, to-wit:

10.13 Barbed Wire. It shall be unlawful for any person to construct, set up or maintain any barbed wire or barbed wire fence or enclosure within the city. Violation of this section is a Class C violation.

Section 10.13 Barbed Wire is hereby amended and adopted with the provision that Section 10.13 shall not apply to the maintenance of an existing barbed wire fence at the time of the adoption of this Ordinance No. 1672.

No fewer than three copies of said Uniform Public Offense Code shall be marked or stamped “Official Copy as Adopted by Ordinance No. 1672” with all sections or portions thereof intended to be omitted or changed clearly marked to show any such omission or changes to which shall be attached a copy of this ordinance, and filed with the City Clerk to be open to inspection and available to the public at all reasonable hours.

SECTION 2: REPEAL. Ordinance numbered 1663 is repealed.

SECTION 3: EFFECTIVE DATE. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the governing body, approval by the Mayor, and publication in the official city newspaper.
