

ORDINANCE NO. 329

AN ORDINANCE authorizing emergency appropriation for the Water Department of the Town of College Place, and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Town Council of the Town of College Place, Washington:

Section 1. That after the budget was prepared for the Town of College Place for the year of 1968 and during the latter part of the year of 1967, it was found that it was not possible to complete the drilling of what is known as Well No. 3, located on a tract of land purchased from Dell Wagner, and for which well Permit No. 7218 was assigned to the Town by the Department of Conservation of the State of Washington. It was further found that the unexpended portion of the 1967 Budget providing for said construction would not carry over into the year of 1968 thereby necessitating an emergency appropriation for the continued construction of said well and related facilities.

Section 2. That it was found that by reason of unanticipated extras in the drilling of the well which required the installation of more large size pipe and liner than was called for in the contract and, also, that from the consulting engineers recommendations and the requirements of the well drilling contractor that under-reaming and other methods would be required calling for additional expenditures. That it was also found that additional land was required in order to provide area within which to service and take care of the completed well.

Section 3. That by reason of the foregoing unanticipated matters, it has been found that it required the sum of \$11,810.75 to complete said well and to acquire the land necessary to be used with it. That it was and is necessary that said well be completed as soon as possible in order to comply with the requirements of the Department of Conservation and to also make water available at such time as it would be required by the residents of the Town of College Place and customers of the Water Department. That such additional requirements could not reasonably have been anticipated at the time of the preparation of the 1968 Budget and by reason thereof an emergency does exist.

Section 4. That an emergency is hereby declared and emergency appropriation is hereby made in the sum of \$11,810.75 for the purpose of completing what is known as Well No. 3, and which is covered by Permit No. 7218 of the Department of Conservation of the State of Washington.

Section 5. That this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety of the people of the Town of College Place, and for the purpose of providing adequate water for the Water Department and for the purpose of completing said well in accordance with the requirements of the Department of Conservation. An

emergency therefore exists and it is hereby declared that this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage and posting as required by law.
