

ORDINANCE NO. 557

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 479 PROVIDING FOR A REVISED SANITATION FEE TO BE CHARGED BY THE CITY OF COLLEGE PLACE AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

Section 1: Ordinance No. 479 is amended to increase the sanitation fees from the present shown in Ordinance No. 516, Section 15, Schedule of Service Charges, to the rates as follows:

Schedule for Service Charges: The rates of garbage, refuse, swill, and trash service shall be as follows:

The rates for residents shall include, at no additional cost, a small pile of tree or shrubbery trimmings no larger than three (3) feet square and two (2) feet high, or other trash not exceeding those dimensions. Additional trash in excess of the allowable amount will cost the resident an additional amount based on the above standard charge.

All garbage cans and trash shall be accessible to the collector of Solid Waste and within fifteen (15) feet from the stopping point of the truck on the street or alley, as the case may be.

Section 2: All other sections of Ordinance No. 479 shall remain in force and this amendment shall not be construed to alter or change any of the items set forth in Ordinance No. 479.


Section 3. Separability: If any Section, provision, or part thereof, of this Ordinance shall be adjudged to be invalid or unconstitutional, such adjudication shall not affect the validity of the Ordinance as a whole or any section, provision, or part thereof not adjudicated invalid or unconstitutional.

Section 4: This Ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of public peace, health and safety of the people of the City of College Place, Washington and for the purpose of effecting the maintenance and collection of sanitation bills. An emergency is hereby declared to exist and this ordinance shall be in full force and effect commencing the 1st day of January, 1985, and from said date from and after the passage, approval, posting as required by law.
