

ORDINANCE NO. 658

AN ORDINANCE amending Ordinance No. 609 relating to custodial standard in the operation of the holding cell.

BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of College Place, Washington as follows:

Section 1: The following Section 1 of Ordinance No. 609 is amended and shall read as follows:

Because the State Legislature passed SHB738 (Chapter 462, Laws of 1987) effective July 26, 1987, which sunsets the State Correction Standards Board, it is now necessary for the City to adopt custodial standards for the operation of its holding facility. At this time and upon the recommendation of the Washington Cities Insurance Authority (the City's insurance carrier), the current State standards as delineated in Chapters 289-14 through 289-24 WAC and any subsequent modifications, are hereby adopted by reference. These standards outline the operating standards for jail facilities.

The underlined words represent the changes that have been made.

Section 2 - Effective Date: This ordinance shall take effect and be in full force five (5) days after its passage and publication as provided by law.

ORDINANCE NO. 659

AN ORDINANCE amending section 1 of Ordinance No. 449, entitled the "Washington Model Traffic Ordinance," by deleting therefrom certain state statutes adopted by reference and deleting reference to Washington State Session Laws.

BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of College Place, Washington as follows:

Section 1: Section 1 of Ordinance 449 is amended to read as follows:

Section 1: ADOPTING BY REFERENCE: The "Washington Model Traffic Ordinance," Chapter 46.90 RCW, hereinafter referred to as the "MTO" is hereby adopted by reference as and for the traffic ordinance of the City of College Place as is set forth in full herein with the exception of the penalty provisions thereof which are superseded by the penalty provisions of this ordinance as set forth in Section 3 and except as provided in Section 2.

Section 2: This ordinance shall take effect and be in full force five (5) days after its passage and publication as provided by law.
