## City of College Place, Washington ORDINANCE NO. 18-005

AN ORDINANCE BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COLLEGE PLACE, WASHINGTON TO AMEND COLLEGE PLACE MUNICIPAL CODE SECTION 3.42.055 (C) PROPOSALS, FOR THE INAUGURAL YEAR 2018 ONLY, TO ALLOW ACCEPTANCE OF AN APPLICATION IN EARLY 2018 FOR A FUNDING AWARD TO BE MADE IN EARLY 2018

Whereas, the City of College Place is a non-charter code city governed by the rules and regulations of RCW 35A; and

Whereas, College Place Municipal Code Section 3.42.055 (C) specifies that applications for lodging tax funds are received in one year for funding in the following year; and

Whereas, it would be in the best interest of the City to use some of the lodging tax funding for an advertisement promoting the community; and

**Whereas**, time was not available in the 2017 calendar year to process and approve applications for funding requests;

Now therefore, the City Council of the City of College Place do hereby Ordain as follows:

**Section 1:** Ordinance No. 18-005 is hereby adopted amending College Place Municipal Code Section 3.42.055 (C) Proposals, with language in section 2 of this Ordinance.

Section 2: CPMC 3.42.55 (C) Proposals. The city administrator shall accept proposals from parties interested in competing for estimated lodging tax funds available in the following year. Except that the inaugural year 2018, proposals for funding may be submitted and approved in the same year. Such proposals shall be submitted in written form using a city provided form. Any proposals which are not eligible under the relevant RCWs or which are not selected for recommendation to the city council shall be returned by the LTAC to the city administrator who shall give timely written notice to the submitters.

**Section 3: Severability.** If any section, subsection, paragraph, sentence, clause, or phrase of this ordinance is declared unconstitutional or invalid for any reason, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this ordinance.

**Section 4: Effective Date.** This ordinance shall take effect and be in full force five days after its passage and publication as provided by law.
