

ORDINANCE NO. 440

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 7-204 OF ARTICLE II OF CHAPTER VII OF THE CITY OF WATFORD CITY ORDINANCES RELATING TO DESTROYING DANGEROUS DOGS OR CATS

Be it ordained by the City Council of the City of Watford City, North Dakota:


7-204 Prohibition and Control of Dangerous Dogs or Cats

Except as otherwise permitted in this chapter, it shall be unlawful for any person to own, keep or harbor a dangerous dog or cat within the city limits, and any animal found to be the subject of the violation of this ordinance shall be subject to immediate seizure and impoundment.

Upon Order of the Court, a dangerous dog or cat may be destroyed if it poses a continuing danger.

Gravos moved the adoption of the foregoing Ordinance. The motion was seconded by Riley. On roll call vote of the Council members, the following Council members voted "AYE": Gravos, Devlin, Beard, Riely, Liebel, and Sanford and the following Council members voted "NAY": None. Absent and not voting: None.
