A RESOLUTION AND ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE DISTRICT MAP FOR THE CITY OF

TEMPLE, GEORGIA; REPEALING ALL PRIOR ORDINANCES AND REPLACING THE SAME; TO

PROVIDE SEVERABILITY; TO PROVIDE FOR REPEAL OF CONFLICTING ORDINANCES AND

PROVISIONS; TO PROVIDE FOR ADOPTION AND EFFECTIVE DATE; TO PROVIDE FOR

CODIFICATION; AND TO PROVIDE FOR OTHER LAWFUL PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, pursuant to the Home Rule powers set forth in Georgia law, a municipality may undertake the redistricting of its voting districts during a census year;

And

WHEREAS, the City of Temple has determined a need to rebalance its voting districts;

And

WHEREAS, the City of Temple held two public hearings on its redistricting plan and has submitted the same to the United States Department of Justice for Pre-clearance under the Voting Rights Act;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the Mayor and Council that the Districting Map

Attached hereto as Exhibit A is hereby adopted and shall become the official districting map for the City of Temple, Georgia. It shall further be ordained that the City Clerk provide a copy of the new voting district map to the Carroll County Board of Elections and display a copy of the same at City Hall.

1. Effective Date

This Resolution and Ordinance shall become effective with its adoption.

2. Severability

In the event any portion of this ordinance shall be declared or adjudged invalid or unconstitutional, it is the intention of the City that such adjudication shall in no manner affect the other sections, sentences, clauses, or phrases of the ordinance which shall remain in full force and effect as if the invalid or unconstitutional section, sentence, clause or phrase were not originally a part of the ordinance.

3. Repealer

All ordinances and parts of ordinances in direct conflict with this ordinance is hereby repealed.

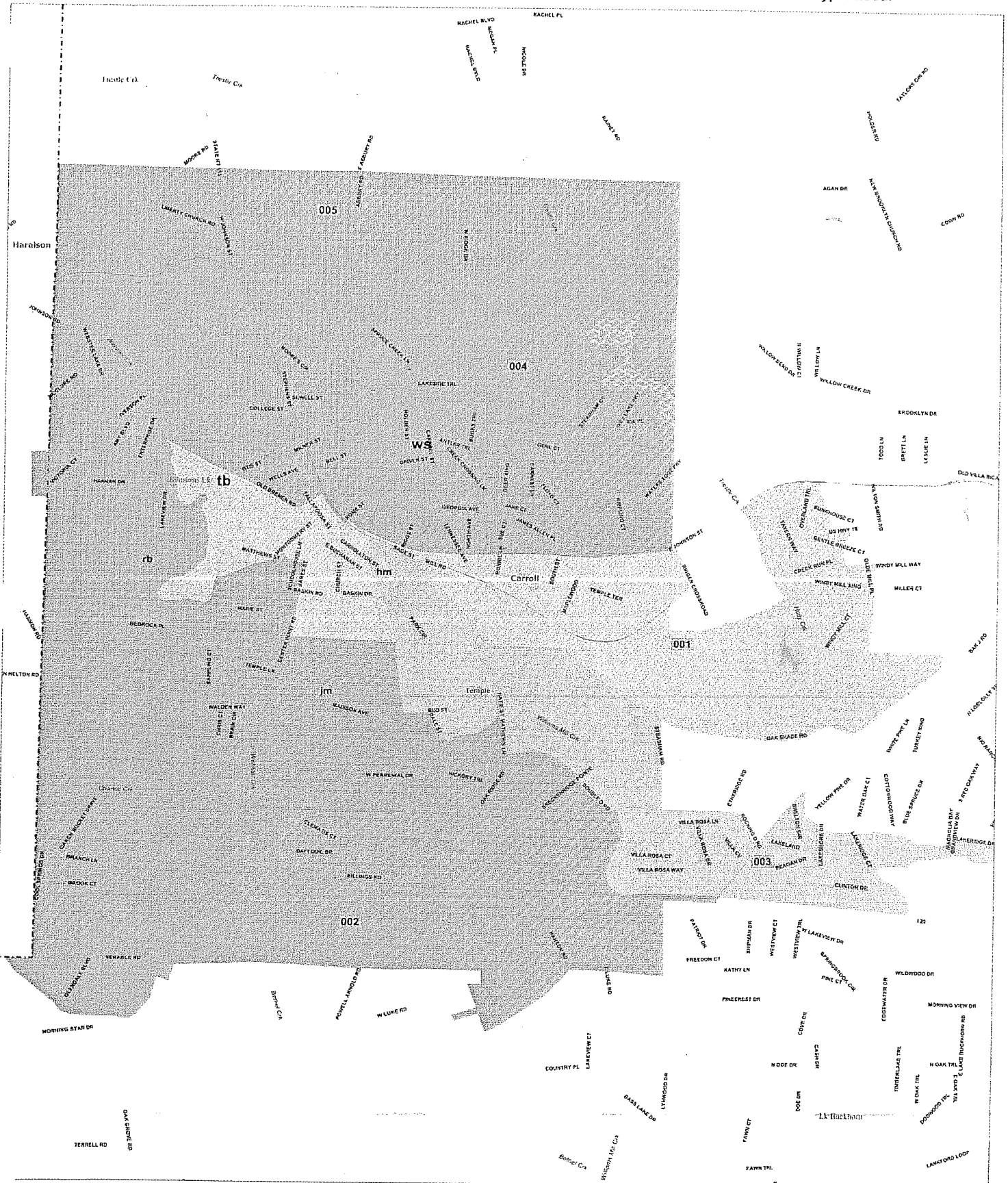
