



**ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING AN  
INTER-GOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT WITH CUMBERLAND PSD**

WHEREAS, the City has completed engineering design and required administrative services for the development of certain real property owned by the City in the southeastern quadrant of John Nash Boulevard and Interstate 77, Bluefield, Mercer County, West Virginia;

WHEREAS, such development will require an addition to and the relocation of an existing water line situate upon such real property, which water line is owned by the Cumberland Public Service District ("PSD"); and

WHEREAS, the City has requested PSD to install and relocate install such existing line under the terms of an Inter-governmental Agreement to be entered into between the City and PSD; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Directors of the City of Bluefield deems it to be in the best interest of the City to enter into such Inter-Governmental Agreement.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, AS FOLLOWS:

That the Board of Directors of the City of Bluefield authorizes the City to enter into an Inter-Governmental Agreement with the Cumberland Public Service District, which agreement provides for the addition to and relocation of an existing water line owned by Cumberland Public Service District on the real property owned by City in the southeastern quadrant of John Nash Boulevard and Interstate 77, Bluefield, Mercer County, West Virginia; and

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, that the Board of Directors of the City of Bluefield authorizes and directs the Mayor to execute such Inter-Governmental Agreement on behalf of the City.
