However, Title 2 TRO, "Animals" has now been amended to permit the burial of farm animals on an AG-zoned land of 80 acres or more, if the burial comports with Oklahoma Department of Agriculture guidelines. Therefore, the Nuisance ordinance must be amended to be consistent.

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING TITLE 24 TULSA REVISED ORDINANCES (TRO), "NUISANCES", CHAPTER 1, "NUISANCES CLASSIFIED", SECTION 101, "NUISANCES AFFECTING HEALTH", SUB-SECTION B., "HEALTH NUISANCES", PARAGRAPH 3; DECLARING THAT ANIMAL CARCASSES WHICH HAVE NOT BEEN DISPOSED OF IN ACCORD WITH TITLE 2 TRO, "ANIMALS", CHAPTER 5, "DEAD ANIMALS" SHALL BE CONSIDERED A NUISANCE; REPEALING ANY ORDINANCE IN CONFLICT HERewith; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF TULSA, OKLAHOMA:

Section 1. That Title 24 TRO, "Nuisances", Chapter 1, "Nuisances Classified", Section 101, "Nuisances Affecting Health", Sub-Section B, "Health Nuisances", paragraph 3 be amended to read as follows:

3. Carcasses of animals not disposed of within twenty-four (24) hours after death in accordance with Title 2 TRO, "Animals", Chapter 5, "Dead Animals";

Section 2. REPEAL OF CONFLICTING ORDINANCES. That all ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith be and the same are now expressly repealed.

Section 3. SEVERABILITY CLAUSE. If any section, subsection, paragraph, subparagraph, sentence, clause or phrase of this Ordinance shall be declared invalid for any reason whatsoever, such decision shall not affect the remaining portions of this Ordinance, which shall remain in full force and effect, and to this end, the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby declared to be severable.

Section 4. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. That an emergency is now declared to exist for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety by reason whereof this ordinance shall take effect immediately from and after its adoption, approval and publication.







AN ORDINANCE AMENDING TITLE 24 TULSA REVISED ORDINANCES (TRO), "NUISANCES", CHAPTER 1, "NUISANCES CLASSIFIED", SECTION 101, "NUISANCES AFFECTING HEALTH", SUB-SECTION B., "HEALTH NUISANCES", PARAGRAPH 3; DECLARING THAT ANIMAL CARCASSES WHICH HAVE NOT BEEN DISPOSED OF IN ACCORD WITH TITLE 2 TRO, "ANIMALS", CHAPTER 5, "DEAD ANIMALS" SHALL BE CONSIDERED A NUISANCE; REPEALING ANY ORDINANCE IN CONFLICT HERewith; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF TULSA, OKLAHOMA:

Section 1. That Title 24 TRO, "Nuisances", Chapter 1, "Nuisances Classified", Section 101, "Nuisances Affecting Health", Sub-Section B, "Health Nuisances", paragraph 3 be amended to read as follows:

3. Carcasses of animals not ~~buried or otherwise~~ disposed of in a sanitary manner within twenty-four (24) hours after death in accordance with Title 2 TRO, "Animals", Chapter 5, "Dead Animals";

Section 2. REPEAL OF CONFLICTING ORDINANCES. That all ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith be and the same are now expressly repealed.

Section 3. SEVERABILITY CLAUSE. If any section, subsection, paragraph, subparagraph, sentence, clause or phrase of this Ordinance shall be declared invalid for any reason whatsoever, such decision shall not affect the remaining portions of this Ordinance, which shall remain in full force and effect, and to this end, the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby declared to be severable.

Section 4. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. That an emergency is now declared to exist for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety by reason whereof this ordinance shall take effect immediately from and after its adoption, approval and publication.
