**ORDINANCE
NO. 2015 - 185**

**An Ordinance to Amend Chapter 25, Article VII , by Amending Section 25-151(a) of
the Code of Ordinances of the City of Elmira, as amended.**

By Councilmember Parks:

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the City of Elmira, duly convened in regular session this 15th day of June, 2015, as follows:

Section 1. That Chapter 25, Article VII, Section 25-151(a), of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Elmira, New York, be and hereby is amended to read as follows:

**CHAPTER 25
ARTICLE VII
STOPPING, STANDING AND PARKING
SECTION 25-151**

Section 25-151. Parking and standing prohibited.

Parking and standing are prohibited in the following parking areas and driveways of hospitals or parking area of a shopping center or the parking area and private streets or roadways of a private apartment house complex or the parking areas and driveways of a private condominium complex:

(a) *North of river.*

Arnot Ogden Hospital, in restricted areas.

Bragg Towers, in restricted areas.

Carpenter Apartments, in restricted areas.

Chemung County Infirmary (Chemung County Nursing Facility),
in restricted areas in front of the building.

Clemens Manor, in restricted areas.

Eastgate/Harriet Homes, in restricted areas.

Elmira College, in restricted area in front of Twin Towers, off W.

Seventh St., this area to also be designated as a tow-away zone.

Elmira Free Academy, in restricted areas on the circular entrance and
exit off Hoffman St.

Elmira Psychiatric Center in restricted areas.

Hathorn Court and Hathorn Annex, in restricted areas.

Hoffman Plaza, in restricted areas.

Riverview Apartments, in restricted areas.
St. Joseph's Hospital, in restricted areas.
Wegmans, in restricted areas.
Weis Market, in restricted areas.

Section 2. All ordinances and parts of ordinances heretofore passed which are in conflict or are inconsistent with any provision or provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed.

Section 3. **Effective Date.** This ordinance shall take effect immediately upon adoption and publication according to law.
