

## AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE ZONING ORDINANCE REMOVING GAMBLING AND GAMING OPERATIONS AS USES

City Council of the City of Thomasville

The City Council finds that the Zoning Ordinance of the City of Thomasville contains language which may be construed to suggest that certain gambling activities which are criminal in North Carolina are permissible in Thomasville. Therefore, to clarify the intent of the Zoning Ordinance, the Council further finds that it would be beneficial to specifically address the illegality of such activities.

THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED that the Zoning Ordinance is hereby amended as follows:

Section 2, "Table of permitted uses," Of Article V "District Regulations," is hereby amended to add to the table the following sentence in the paragraph describing amusements as a permitted use:

"All gambling and other activities which are described in NCGS Sections 14-292 through NCGS Sections 14-309, to which reference is made, are prohibited and not to be interpreted as amusements for purposes of this table or the Zoning Ordinance."

This Ordinance shall be effective at the time of this passage.

Upon the motion of Member of Council Scott Styers, and a second by Member of Council Wendy Sellars, the foregoing ordinance was passed upon its first reading by a vote of 6-0.
