

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING DEFERRED COMPENSATION
PLAN AGREEMENTS WITH EMPLOYEES OF HILLSBOROUGH
COUNTY, COUNTY AGENCIES AND CONSTITUTIONAL
OFFICES WITHIN THE COUNTY.

WHEREAS, Chapter 76-279, Laws of Florida, amended
Section 112.215, Florida Statutes, authorizing deferred
compensation plans and provided that any county or other
political subdivision of the State may by ordinance adopt
and establish for itself and its employees deferred com-
pensation programs.

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners is the only
political body authorized to adopt ordinances for the un-
incorporated area of Hillsborough County.

WHEREAS, it appears to be in the best interest of the
employees of Hillsborough County, the public agencies,
political subdivisions and constitutional officers of the
county to be able to enter into deferred compensation agree-
ments with their employers. Now, therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF
HILLSBOROUGH COUNTY:

SECTION 1: The Board of County Commissioners as an
employer and each constitutional officer, political sub-
division or County public agency operating within the county
which operates independently from the Board of County
Commissioners as an employer is hereby authorized to adopt a
deferred compensation program and to enter into deferred
compensation agreements with employees under the provisions
of Section 112.215, Florida Statutes, provided that each
employer shall follow the procedure prescribed in Section
112.215, Florida Statutes, and shall file its deferred com-
pensation plan with the Hillsborough County Administrator.

SECTION 2: "Employer" means the Board of County
Commissioners, each constitutional officer, each autonomous
political subdivision and each County or public agency
operating in the County employing personnel or contracting

with independent contractors. The term "Employee" means any person whether appointed, elected or under contract, providing services for an employer.

SECTION 3: Each employer publishing a deferred compensation plan agreement under the provisions of Section 112.215, Florida Statutes, shall enter into an agreement with any employee, upon his request, to defer a portion of that employee's future compensation, and may with such deferred compensation purchase a life insurance contract or annuity contract or make other appropriate investments, as it may approve, as provided by Section 112.215, Florida Statutes.

SECTION 4: The employer shall be the sole owner and beneficiary of any deferred compensation investments or contracts purchased with deferred compensation, shall exercise all rights of ownership thereto, and shall pay or caused to be paid when due to the employee or his beneficiary all of the benefits and proceeds of any investment or contract.

SECTION 5: Each employer shall appoint a committee of three persons, none of whom shall be an employee, to administer the agreement. The committee is hereby authorized and directed to establish the necessary procedures for the implementation of the deferred compensation agreement and to perform such other duties as may be necessary under the agreement on behalf of the employer. Decisions of the committee shall be by a majority vote, and one member of the committee may execute any instruments on behalf of the committee.

SECTION 6: This ordinance is adopted pursuant to the directions contained in Section 112.215, Florida Statutes, and shall be construed in para materia therewith.

SECTION 7: This ordinance shall become effective upon filing with the Department of State.
