ORDINANCE NO. 21-028

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE 20-026, TO LEVY TAX FOR THE CITY OF GREENWOOD FOR 2021

WHEREAS, Greenwood County Tax Assessor has completed a reassessment of all properties within the County and City of Greenwood; and,

WHEREAS, South Carolina Code of Laws, Section 6-1-320, provides that in the year in which a reassessment program is implemented, the rollback millage, as calculated pursuant to Section 12-37-251(E) must be used in lieu of the previous year's millage; and,

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Greenwood desires to comply with South Carolina Code of Laws, Section 6-1-320.

BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Greenwood in meeting assembled:

Section 1 That a tax to cover the period from January 1 to December 31, 2021, both inclusive; for the sums and in the manner hereinafter mentioned, is and shall be levied, collected, and paid into the treasury of the City of Greenwood for the use and service thereof; i.e., a tax of \$11.41 on every \$100 in assessed value of real estate and personal property of every description owned and used in the City of Greenwood, South Carolina, except such as is exempt from taxation under the Constitution and laws of the State of South Carolina, is and shall be levied and paid into the City Treasury for the credit to the City of Greenwood for the corporate purposes, permanent improvements and for the purpose of paying current expenses of said municipality; making a total levy of 114.1 mills. Motor vehicles located within the City of Greenwood shall be subject to a levy of 114.1 mills as provided by the 2021 Tax Millage Ordinance and by State law. Such tax is levied on such property as is assessed for taxation for County and State purposes.


Section 2 (A) All taxes shall be due and payable January 17, 2022, with a penalty of 3 percent on January 18, 2022; 10 percent on February 1, 2022; and 15 percent on March 15, 2022.

(B) Taxes not paid on or before March 15, 2022, shall go into execution. The actual costs and expenses incurred in connection with the execution to enforce the payment of delinquent taxes and penalties shall be added and collected by the municipality.

This ordinance duly adopted on second reading this 27th day of September 2021.
