

ORDINANCE NO. 3898  
(Amending Henderson Municipal Code  
Chapter 15.16 – National Electrical Code)

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HENDERSON,  
NEVADA, TO AMEND PORTIONS OF CHAPTER 15.16 – NATIONAL  
ELECTRICAL CODE.

WHEREAS, pursuant to the provisions of the Henderson City Charter, Section 2.180, the City Council is authorized to regulate all matters relating to construction, maintenance and safety of buildings, structures, and property within the City, and to adopt building or safety codes as are deemed necessary to carry out this purpose; and

WHEREAS, the City of Henderson has adopted the 2017 National Electrical Code (NEC), including the Southern Nevada Amendments to the 2017 National Electrical Code; and

WHEREAS, the City Council adopted Ordinance No. 3507 on August 7, 2018, with an effective date of February 4, 2019; and

NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Henderson, Nevada, does ordain:

SECTION 1. This ordinance does not affect the effective date or provisions of Ordinance No. 3507, except as noted herein.

SECTION 2. Henderson Municipal Code, Chapter 15.16.010 – Adoption by reference - is hereby amended as follows:

15.16.010 Adoption by reference.

The City of Henderson adopts as its electrical code the [2018] 2017 National Electrical Code as published by the National Fire Protection Association in its entirety excepting amendments and changes as stated in this chapter. Three copies of this code are on file in the office of the City Clerk.

SECTION 3. Henderson Municipal Code, Chapter 15.16.020 – Code amended - is hereby amended as follows:

15.16.020 Code amended.

The City of Henderson adopts as amendments to the [2018] 2017 National Electrical Code the booklet entitled "Southern Nevada Amendments to the [2018] 2017 National Electrical Code" amending the [2018] 2017 National Electrical Code. The booklet is adopted in its entirety excepting amendments and changes as stated in this chapter. Three copies of this booklet are on file in the office of the City Clerk.

Amending Henderson Municipal Code Chapter 15.16 – National Electrical Code

SECTION 4. If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase, provision or portion of this Ordinance, or the application thereof to any person or circumstances, is for any reason held to be invalid or unconstitutional by the decision of any court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions or provisions of this Ordinance or their applicability to distinguishable situations or circumstances.

SECTION 5. All ordinances, or parts of ordinances, sections, subsections, phrases, sentences, clauses or paragraphs contained in the Municipal Code of the City of Henderson, Nevada, in conflict herewith are repealed and replaced as appropriate.


SECTION 6. A copy of this Ordinance shall be filed with the office of the City Clerk, and notice of such filing shall be published once by title in the Las Vegas Review-Journal, a newspaper having general circulation in the City of Henderson, at least ten (10) days prior to the adoption of said Ordinance (Initial Publication). Following adoption by the City Council, this Ordinance shall be published by title together with the names of the Council members voting for or against passage (Final Publication). This Ordinance is scheduled for Final Publication on August 5, 2022, in the Las Vegas Review-Journal, at which time it will become effective.

“COUNCIL AS A WHOLE”


