

ORDINANCE NO. 3122
(Repeal and Replace Henderson Municipal Code Chapter 2.34)

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HENDERSON, NEVADA, TO REPEAL CHAPTER 2.34 – UNCLASSIFIED EMPLOYEES - OF THE HENDERSON MUNICIPAL CODE IN ITS ENTIRETY AND MATTERS PROPERLY RELATED THERETO AND ESTABLISH A NEW CHAPTER 2.34 – ADMINISTRATIVE POLICIES.

- WHEREAS, Resolution No. 119, adopted on July 15, 1963, adopted Section 2.34.025; and
WHEREAS, Resolution No. 409, adopted on March 18, 1974, added Section 2.34.140; and
WHEREAS, Resolution No. 729, adopted on September 22, 1980, revised Chapter 2.34; and
WHEREAS, Resolution No. 1271, adopted on January 1, 1988, added Section 2.34.110 and was revised by Resolution No. 1504 on May 14, 1991; and
WHEREAS, in order for the public to maintain trust in its public servants, certain guidelines should be established; and

NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Henderson, Nevada, does ordain:

- SECTION 1. Chapter 2.34 Unclassified Employees is hereby repealed in its entirety and a new Chapter 2.34 Administrative Policies established as follows:

Section:

2.34.10 – Adoption by Reference of Administrative Policy Manual

That the City of Henderson's "Administrative Policy Manual", three copies of which are on file in the office of the City Clerk, is hereby adopted and by this reference is made a part of this Code, to the same effect as if set out in full herein. The City Manager is authorized to revise the "Administrative Policy Manual", in whole or in part and from time to time as the need arises. Any revision shall indicate the fact of City Manager approval and the approval date or effective date, and shall be filed in the office of the City Clerk.

- SECTION 2. If any section, subsection, paragraph, clause or provision of this Ordinance shall for any reason be held invalid or unenforceable, the invalidity or unenforceability of such section or subsection, paragraph, clause or provision shall not affect any of the remaining provisions of this Ordinance.
- SECTION 3. All ordinances, or parts of ordinances, sections, subsection, phrases, sentences, clauses or paragraphs contained in the Municipal Code of the City of Henderson, Nevada, in conflict herewith are repealed and replaced as appropriate.

SECTION 4. A copy of this Ordinance shall be filed with the office of the City Clerk, and notice of such filing shall be published once by title in the Review Journal, a newspaper having general circulation in the City of Henderson, at least ten (10) days prior to the adoption of said Ordinance, and following approval shall be published by title (or in full if the Council by majority vote so orders) together with the names of the Councilmen voting for or against passage for at least one (1) publication before the Ordinance shall become effective. This Ordinance is scheduled for publication on February 21, 2014, in the Review Journal.


