

RESOLUTION NO. 4171
(IRS-CI – Las Vegas Financial Crimes Task Force)

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HENDERSON,
NEVADA, RATIFYING THE MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING
BETWEEN THE INTERNAL REVENUE SERVICE, CRIMINAL
INVESTIGATION (IRS-CI) AND CITY OF HENDERSON POLICE
DEPARTMENT AUTHORIZING PARTICIPATION IN THE LAS VEGAS
FINANCIAL CRIMES TASK FORCE.

WHEREAS, the City of Henderson, Nevada (the “City”), is charged with providing police services to the citizens of Henderson; and

WHEREAS, a rapid, proactive, and intelligence-driven investigative response to sexual victimization of children and other crimes against children in the United States; to identify and rescue child victims; to reduce the vulnerability of children to sexual exploitation and abuse; to reduce the negative impact of domestic and international parental rights disputes; and to strengthen the capabilities of the FBI and federal, state, local and international law enforcement through training, intelligence-sharing, technical support, and investigative assistance; and

WHEREAS, it is in the public's best interest that any suspected activities be investigated and managed by a coordinated task force effort made up of federal, state and local law enforcement; and

WHEREAS pursuant to NRS 239C.210 documents that address or contain information about tactical operations by a response agency are deemed confidential and are not accessible to the public, and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Henderson, Nevada, that:

SECTION 1. The City hereby approves and ratifies the Memorandum of Understanding between the Internal Revenue Service, Criminal Investigation (IRS-CI) and the Henderson Police Department, and authorizing participation in the Las Vegas Financial Crimes Task Force.

SECTION 2. The authority to execute the Memorandum of Understanding by the Chief of Police is hereby confirmed and ratified.


SECTION 3. Pursuant to NRS 239C.210 the terms and provisions of the Memorandum of Understanding are deemed confidential.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this resolution is effective upon adoption unless stated otherwise.
