

ORDINANCE NO. 1246

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND TITLE 2, CHAPTER 1, SECTION 1 OF THE CONYERS CODE OF ORDINANCES TO CHANGE THE CITY COUNCIL MEETING TIME FROM 7:00 P.M. TO 6:00 PM; TO PROVIDE AN EFFECTIVE DATE; TO REPEAL ALL ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, Section 2-403 of the City of Conyers Charter requires that the City Council set the date and time of regular meetings of the Council by ordinance; and

WHEREAS, as stated in Section 2-1-1 of the City of Conyers Code of Ordinances, the City of Conyers (hereinafter "City") currently holds its Council Meetings on the 1st and 3rd Wednesday of each month beginning at 7:00 PM; and

WHEREAS, the City Council desires to change the council meeting time from 7:00 PM to 6:00 PM on the 1st and 3rd Wednesday of each month.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED that it is the intention of the City Council and it hereby is ordained by the authority of same that the provisions of this Ordinance shall become and be made a part of the Code of the City of Conyers, Georgia, and the sections of the code and this ordinance may be renumbered to accomplish that intention, and that Title 2, Chapter 1, Section 1 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Conyers, Georgia, is hereby amended as follows:

SECTION 1. Section 2-1-1(a) of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Conyers, Georgia is hereby amended. For the purposes of clarity, the entirety of the new code section is set forth, below.

Sec. 2-1-1. - Regular meetings; special meetings.

(a) Regular meetings of the City Council shall be held at the City Hall on the first and third Wednesdays of each month at 6:00 p.m.

(b) Where the day for a regular meeting falls upon a day which is a legal holiday in this State, the meeting shall be held upon a day and at an hour to be designated by the Mayor at least four days before the legal holiday, at which meeting all matters shall be taken up which might have come before the meeting as regularly set.

(c) Special meetings of the City Council may be held on call as provided in the City Charter.

(d) Only business stated in the call may be transacted at a special meeting.

(e) Reserved.

(f) Any meeting of the City Council may be continued or adjourned from day to day, or for more than one day, but no adjournment shall be for a longer period than until the next regular meeting thereafter.


SECTION 2. The preamble to this Ordinance is hereby incorporated by reference into this Ordinance as if fully set forth herein.

SECTION 3. All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances in conflict with this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

SECTION 4. If any section, subsection, provisions, or clause of any part of this Ordinance shall be declared invalid or unconstitutional or, if the provisions of any part of this Ordinance as applied to any particular situation or set of circumstances shall be declared invalid or unconstitutional, such invalidity shall not be construed to affect the portions of this Ordinance not so held to be invalid, or the application of this Ordinance to other circumstances not so held to be invalid. It is hereby declared as the intent of the City Council that this Ordinance would have been adopted in its current form without the invalid or unconstitutional provision contained therein.

SECTION 5. Pursuant to Section 2-402(a)(4) of the Charter of the City of Conyers, Georgia, the second reading of this Ordinance is hereby waived in order to permit this Ordinance to become effective upon its adoption by the City Council and upon its execution by the Mayor.
