

ORDINANCE NO. 1435





Figure 1.01 Local Street – 50' ROW.

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND CHAPTER 6 OF TITLE 8 OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF CONYERS, GEORGIA, SO AS TO AMEND DIVISION 1 (ROADWAY IMPROVEMENTS) OF ARTICLE 11 (STANDARD DESIGN AND CONSTRUCTION DETAIL); TO AMEND THE UTILITY PLACEMENT STANDARDS IN FIGURE 1.01 FOR LOCAL STREETS WITH A 50-FOOT RIGHT-OF-WAY; FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

BE IT HEREBY ORDAINED by the Mayor and Council of the City of Conyers, Georgia:

SECTION 1. That Figure 1.01 in Division 1, Roadway Improvements, of Article 11, Standard design and Construction Detail of the Subdivision Regulations of the City of Conyers, Georgia is hereby amended so as to insert the following in its respective location:

SECTION 2. All ordinances or parts of an ordinance in conflict with this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

SECTION 3. If any said section, subsection, provision, or clause or any part of this Ordinance shall be declared invalid or unconstitutional, or if the provisions of any part of this Ordinance as applied to any particular situation, or set of circumstances shall be declared invalid or unconstitutional, such invalidity shall not be construed to affect the portions of this Ordinance not so held to be invalid, or the application of this Ordinance to other circumstances not so held to be invalid. It is hereby declared as the intent of the Mayor and the City Council that this Ordinance would have been adopted in its current form without the invalid or unconstitutional provision contained therein.


