

**MICHIGAN CITY COMMON COUNCIL**

**ORDINANCE NO. 4220**

**AMENDING THE REGULATION REGARDING THE COMPENSATION OF MEMBERS OF THE COMMISSION ON THE SOCIAL STATUS OF AFRICAN-AMERICAN MALES ESTABLISHED BY SEC. 2-457(C)(2) OF THE MUNICIPAL CODE FOR MICHIGAN CITY, INDIANA**

**WHEREAS**, on October 16, 2012, the Common Council passed Ordinance No. 4200 entitled “*An Ordinance Setting Salaries and Wages for Appointed Officials and Employees of the City of Michigan City, Indiana for the Calendar Year 2013;*”

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to Section 9 of Ordinance No. 4200, members of the Commission on the Social Status of African-American Males shall be paid quarterly at a rate of \$50.00 per month only if the member attends the regularly scheduled meetings with a maximum compensation of \$600.00 per year;

**WHEREAS**, a conflict exists between Ordinance No. 4200 and Sec. 2-457(c)(2) of the Michigan City Municipal Code which currently reads that members of the Commission on the Social Status of African-American Males shall serve without compensation; and

**WHEREAS**, the Common Council desires to resolve said conflict.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED** by the Common Council of the City of Michigan City that Section 2-457(c)(2) of the Michigan City Municipal Code is amended to read as follows:

Compensation of the members, if any, shall be established annually by virtue of an ordinance setting salaries and wages for appointed officials and employees of the City of Michigan City, Indiana.

This Ordinance to be effective upon passage by the Council, approval by the Mayor, any necessary publication, and any necessary approval by the Indiana Department of Local Government Finance.
