Short Title: Prohibited Uses: All persons or legal entitles are prohibited from drilling or mining for any oil, gas, fossil fuel, natural resources or minerals except for water within the City Limits.

ORDINANCE

The City of Alma does hereby adopt the following Ordinance and Amendment to the existing zoning regulations of the City of Alma:

- 1. No person or other legal entity shall be authorized to drill or mine for any oil, gas, fossil fuel, natural resources, or minerals within the city limits in the City of Alma, with the exception of when drilling is permitted for the placement of an authorized and permitted well for the purposes of providing water to the property upon which the well is placed.
- 2. The Zoning regulations for the City of Alma shall be amended to provide for the adoption of section 94-151 which shall read as follows:

Sec. 94-151. Prohibited uses.

Within the city limits of the City of Alma as they currently exist or upon future annexation, with the exception of an appropriate authorized and permitted well for purposes of producing water for the property upon which it is located, all persons or other legal entitles are prohibited from drilling or mining for any oil, gas, fossil fuel, natural resources or minerals.
