AN ORDINANCE OF THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL FOR THE TOWN OF TYRONE TO AMEND THE CODE OF ORDINANCES FOR THE TOWN OF TYRONE TO PROVIDE FOR A REVISION TO AN ORDINANCE TO INCREASE THE SALARIES OF THE TOWN COUNCILMEMBERS; TO PROMOTE THE PUBLIC HEALTH, SAFETY AND WELFARE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL FOR THE TOWN OF TYRONE THAT DUE TO THE FOLLOWING CIRCUMSTANCES:

WHEREAS, On May 2, 2019 the Mayor and Council for the Town Of Tyrone (hereinafter referred to as Mayor and Council) adopted a resolution of intent to increase the salaries of its councilmembers from four hundred dollars (\$400.00) per month to six hundred dollars (\$600.00) per month (said resolution is attached hereto as exhibit "A") and;

WHEREAS, On June 20, 2019, the Mayor and Council took action to carry out this intent by unanimously adopting an ordinance increasing councilmember salaries from four hundred dollars (\$400.00) per month to six hundred dollars (\$600.00) per month; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council memorialized this action through execution of a document known as Ordinance Number 2019-04 (attached hereto as exhibit "B" and henceforth referred to as the "Ordinance") to record that action; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor And Council has found a conflict in the Ordinance wherein the salary of each member of the Town Council is mis-stated as follows: "The salary of each

member of the ... town council shall be **eight-hundred dollars (\$600.00)** per month”[emphasis added]; and

WHEREAS, this conflict must be corrected;

IT IS HEREBY ENACTED PURSUANT TO THE AUTHORITY OF THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL THAT ARTICLE II OF CHAPTER 2 OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES FOR THE TOWN OF TYRONE, PERTAINING TO SALARIES OF COUNCIL, BE AMENDED AS IT PERTAINS TO THE SALARY OF EACH COUNCILMEMBER, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. By deleting Section 2-21(b), pertaining to “Salaries of mayor and council,” of Article II of Chapter 2 of the Tyrone Code of Ordinances, in its entirety and by enacting in lieu thereof an entirely new Section 2-21(b), pertaining to “Salaries of mayor and council,” of Article II of Chapter 2 of the Town of Tyrone Code of Ordinances, to read as follows:

“Sec. 2-21. - Salaries of mayor and council.

(b) The salary of each member of the duly elected and qualified town council shall be six hundred dollars (\$600.00) per month. The town councilmembers shall also be entitled to reimbursement for actual and necessary expenses incurred while on legitimate town business.”

Section 2. All other ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict with this ordinance shall be deemed repealed.

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL FOR THE TOWN OF TYRONE TO EXPRESS THE INTENT OF THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL TO MOVE FORWARD WITH THE CONSIDERATION OF A PROPOSED INCREASE IN THE COMPENSATION OF MAYOR AND MEMBERS OF THE COUNCIL; TO PROMOTE THE PUBLIC HEALTH, SAFETY, AND WELFARE, AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, The Town of Tyrone is a properly established and chartered municipality through HB 1448, passed May 13, 2008 (the "Charter"); and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council are the duly authorized governing body under said Charter; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council is authorized to fix the salaries of the governing authority of the Town of Tyrone pursuant to O.C.G.A. § 36-35-4; and

WHEREAS, the members of the governing body last addressed the compensation of its members in 1984; and

WHEREAS, since that time, there have been significant increases in the cost of living and the remuneration provided similarly situated members of governing authorities; and

WHEREAS, said compensation is set at \$800.00 monthly for the Mayor and \$400 monthly for each member of the town council; and

WHEREAS, said compensation is proposed to be set at \$1200.00 monthly for the Mayor and \$600 monthly for each member of the town council; and

WHEREAS, the members of the governing Authority have indicated a desire to move forward with consideration of an increase in the compensation of the Mayor and each council member.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and Council for the Town of Tyrone that it is the intention of the Mayor and Council, as governing authority of the Town of Tyrone to commence the procedure necessary to increase the compensation of its Mayor and each of its Council Members.

NOW, THEREFORE, HAVING CAUSED THE NOTICE ATTACHED HERETO AS EXHIBIT "A" (AND HEREBY INCORPORATED HEREIN) TO BE PLACED IN THE FAYETTE COUNTY NEWS IN ACCORDANCE WITH O.C.G.A. § 36-35-4 AND RUN ON MAY 29, JUNE 5 AND JUNE 15, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL FOR THE TOWN OF TYRONE AND IT IS HEREBY ENACTED PURSUANT TO THE AUTHORITY OF THE SAME THAT ARTICLE II OF CHAPTER 2 OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES FOR THE TOWN OF TYRONE, PERTAINING TO SALARIES OF MAYOR AND COUNCIL, BE AMENDED AS IT PERTAINS TO THE AMOUNT OF THE SALARY OF THE MAROR AND THE AMOUNT OF THE SALARY OF EACH COUNCIL MEMBER, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. By deleting Section 2-21, pertaining to "Salaries of mayor and council," of Article II of Chapter 2 of the Tyrone Code of Ordinances, in its entirety and by enacting in lieu thereof an entirely new Section 2-21, pertaining to "Salaries of mayor and

council,” of Article II of Chapter 2 of the Town of Tyrone Code of Ordinances, to be read as follows:

Sec. 2-21. - Salaries of mayor and council.

- (a) The salary of the duly elected and qualified mayor of the town shall be one thousand two hundred dollars (\$1,200.00) per month. The mayor shall also be entitled to reimbursement for actual and necessary expenses incurred while on legitimate town business.
- (b) The salary of each member of the duly elected and qualified town council shall be eight hundred dollars (\$800.00) per month. The town councilmembers shall also be entitled to reimbursement for actual and necessary expenses incurred while on legitimate town business.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect immediately upon the taking of office of those elected at the regular municipal election which is to be held on November 2, 2019.


Section 3. All other ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict with this ordinance shall be deemed repealed.

Notice is hereby given for a proposed increase in salary for elected officials of the Town of Tyrone. The proposed salary increase will become effective January 1, 2020. The current salaries of the Mayor and Council members are \$800.00 per month (\$9,600.00 per year) and \$400.00 per month (\$4,800.00 per year) respectively. The proposed salaries are \$1,200.00 per month (\$14,400.00 per year) and \$800.00 per month (\$9,600.00 per year), respectively. A meeting shall be held on the 20th day of June at 7:00 p.m. at Town Hall, 881 Senoia Road, Tyrone, Georgia 30290 before the Mayor and Council of the Town of Tyrone at which time the proposed new salaries shall be considered. All citizens of Tyrone are invited to attend.
