ORDINANCE NO. 08-23

AN ORDINANCE OF THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BUCKEYE, ARIZONA, AMENDING THE BUCKEYE CITY CODE, CHAPTER 12, TRAFFIC CODE, ARTICLE 12-2, TRAFFIC REGULATIONS, SECTION 12-2-8, COMMERCIAL VEHICLE RESTRICTIONS; PROVIDING FOR REPEAL OF CONFLICTING ORDINANCES; AND PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY.

WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Council of the City of Buckeye, Arizona, believe that it is in the best interest of the City to amend the Buckeye City Code related to the service of commercial vehicle parking complaints; and

WHEREAS, this change will improve enforcement of the City's commercial vehicle restrictions and reduce the occurrence of nuisances related to commercial vehicles parked in residential areas.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BUCKEYE, ARIZONA, as follows:

Section 1. The recitals set forth above are hereby incorporated as if fully set forth herein.

Section 2. The Buckeye City Code, Chapter 12 (Traffic Code), Article 12-2 (Traffic Regulations), Section 12-2-8 (Commercial Vehicle Restrictions) is amended by adding a new Subsection M, to read as follows, with all other provisions of Section 12-2-8 remaining unchanged:

- M. In an action for a violation of this Section related to parking, standing, or stopping, the complaint need not be personally served upon the owner or operator of the commercial vehicle but may be served by conspicuously attaching a copy of the complaint to the commercial vehicle.

Section 3. All ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed.

Section 4. If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase, or portion of this Ordinance is for any reason held to be invalid or unconstitutional by the decision of any court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions thereof.

Section 5. The Mayor, the City Manager, the City Clerk, and the City Attorney are hereby authorized and directed to take all steps and to execute all documents necessary to carry out the purpose and intent of this Ordinance.
