**ORDINANCE No. 4 of 2023**

**AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND SECTION 13:31 OF THE  
VERNON PARISH CODE OF ORDINANCES**

**BE IT ORDAINED**, by the Vernon Parish Police Jury, in regular and legal session convened, that the following changes be made to section 13:31 of the Vernon Parish Code of Ordinances:

Reduce the speed limit on Brush Creek Road (#2025), District 2 Ward 2, to 25 MPH, beginning at the Hornbeck town limits to the end.

**BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED**, that any person or persons in violation of this ordinance shall be fined not more than \$500.00 or imprisoned up to thirty (30) days, or both.

**BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED** that all ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are repealed, and this ordinance shall have full force and effect upon its adoption and publication as provided by law.
