

ORDINANCE NO. _____

AN ORDINANCE of the City of Port Angeles, Washington, levying regular ad valorem property taxes for collection in the fiscal year 2023, and directing the City Clerk to certify said amount to the Board of Clallam County Commissioners.

WHEREAS, the City Council intends to levy property taxes for collection in 2023.

WHEREAS, the City Council has adopted a Resolution pursuant to RCW 84.55.120 authorizing for the 2023 levy a 1.4%, or \$68,333.00, increase over the actual levy for 2022.

WHEREAS, the City's actual levy amount form the previous year was \$4,896,443.02; and,

WHEREAS, the City's population is greater than 10,000,

NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Port Angeles do hereby ordain as follows:

Section 1. The amount of the actual levy for the fiscal year commencing January 1, 2023 shall be an increase of \$68,333.00 which is a 1.4 percent increase from the previous year and which includes banked capacity from prior years, plus:

Additional revenue resulting from new construction, improvements to property, newly constructed wind turbines, any increase in the value of state-assessed property, any annexations that have occurred and refunds made.

Section 2. The City Clerk is hereby directed to certify to the Board of Clallam County Commissioners the amount of ad valorem taxes to be levied for the fiscal year commencing January 1, 2023, as set forth in Section 1 of this Ordinance.

Section 3. This ordinance, being an exercise of a power specifically delegated to the City legislative body, is not subject to referendum. This ordinance shall take effect five (5) days after passage and publication of an approved summary thereof consisting of the title.
