

ORDINANCE NO. 2016-26

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE CODE OF THE CITY OF LAWRENCEVILLE,  
GEORGIA, CHAPTER 36, SECTION 36-5 TO PROVIDE FOR A RESTRICTION ON  
OVERNIGHT PARKING

The City Council of the City of Lawrenceville, Georgia hereby ordains that Chapter 36 of the Code of the City of Lawrenceville, Georgia is hereby amended by deleting Section 36-5 – No Parking Rules in its entirety and replacing it with the following:

Sec. 36-5. - No parking rules.

- (a) It shall be unlawful at any time to permit any vehicle to stand, stop or park in any of the following places except in compliance with the directions of a law enforcement official or traffic control device:
- (1) In any intersection;
  - (2) In a crosswalk;
  - (3) Within 20 feet of any intersection or crosswalk;
  - (4) At any place where the vehicle would block the use of the driveway;
  - (5) At any place where the standing, stopping or parking of a vehicle will reduce the useable width of the roadway for moving traffic to less than 20 feet.
  - (6) At any place in the area of Nash Street from Neal Boulevard to Clayton Street next to the Lawrenceville City Hall.
  - (7) Overnight (10pm – 6am) parking shall be prohibited in all public right – of – way. Nothing shall prohibit parking in designated parking spaces.
- (b) The Police Chief or any other person authorized by the Council shall cause signs to be posted in all areas where parking is prohibited.

Except as amended in this Ordinance, all other provisions of Chapter 36 of the Code of the City of Lawrenceville, Georgia, shall remain in full force and effect.
