**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 50-182 (“TRUCK PARKING”) OF ARTICLE
III (“STOPPING, STANDING, AND PARKING”) OF CHAPTER 50 (“TRAFFIC AND
VEHICLES”) OF THE VILLAGE CODE OF THE VILLAGE OF CHICAGO RIDGE**

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AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 50-182 (“TRUCK PARKING”) OF ARTICLE III (“STOPPING, STANDING, AND PARKING”) OF CHAPTER 50 (“TRAFFIC AND VEHICLES”) OF THE VILLAGE CODE OF THE VILLAGE OF CHICAGO RIDGE

WHEREAS, the Village of Chicago Ridge, Cook County, Illinois (the “*Village*”) is a home rule unit of local government pursuant to Article VII, Section 6, of the 1970 Illinois Constitution, and, except as limited by such section, it may exercise any power and perform any function pertaining to its government and affairs; and

WHEREAS, the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Chicago Ridge (the “*Corporate Authorities*”) may from time to time amend the text of the Village Code when it is determined to be in the best interests of the residents of the Village; and

WHEREAS, the Corporate Authorities find that it is in the best interest of the Village to amend the Village Code provisions regarding truck parking regulations; and

WHEREAS the Corporate Authorities find that the above-mentioned amendment is important to protect the health, safety and welfare of Village residents; and

WHEREAS, the Corporate Authorities find it in the best interests of the Village to amend the Village Code provisions regarding the truck parking regulations as further provided below.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Chicago Ridge, Cook County, Illinois, as follows:

Section 1. That the above recital is found to be true and correct and is hereby incorporated herein and made a part hereof, as if fully set forth in its entirety.

Section 2. Section 50-182 (“Truck Parking”) of Article III (“Stopping, Standing, and Parking”) of Chapter 50 (“Traffic and Vehicles”) of the Village Code is hereby amended by adding the underlined language and removing the stricken language to provide as follows:

50-182 TRUCK PARKING

(a) The parking of trucks having an Illinois license plate designation of categories TW, C, D, or F, or weighing between 8,000 and 16,000 lbs. ~~trailers having a state license plate designation of TA, TB, TC or TD~~, shall be permitted within all R-1, R-2, and R-3 Residential Districts in the Village only upon issuance of, and compliance with, a truck parking permit from the Village, except temporarily for loading and unloading purposes as described in subsection (b), or pursuant to work being done under a Village building permit. Truck permit requirements are as follows:

- (1) Only one truck permit is ~~and one trailer permit are~~ permitted for any residence in the Village.
- (2) Applicant must have a valid driver’s license registered to a Village of Chicago Ridge address.
- (3) Vehicles under permit must be parked in the driveway of the residence and not block the sidewalk. No on-street parking is permitted, except for brief intervals for loading, unloading, or switching vehicles from the driveway.
- (4) Trucks must not run unoccupied in the driveway for more than 10 minutes.
- (5) Vehicles that are housed in the Village must also display Chicago Ridge vehicle stickers pursuant to section 50-263.
- (6) Permit stickers must be displayed on the vehicle’s front bumper ~~in lower corner of rear window or, if vehicle does not have a rear window, in lower front window on passenger side.~~
- (7) If permit application is for truck with out-of-state plates, applicant must affirm that truck weight is 16,000 lbs. or less.

(b) ~~Trucks~~ No person shall stop or park a truck or permit a truck having a state license plate designation higher than in excess of category F or weighing in excess of 16,000 lbs. ~~a trailer with a plate designation in excess of category TD to shall not stop, park, or stand~~ at any time within all R-1, R-2, and R-3 Residential Districts in the Village, except in the case where the property on the vehicle is being unloaded for use on the premises where the vehicle is parked, or property from the premises is being loaded onto the vehicle, and the vehicle departs the premises as soon as reasonably possible after completion, or not longer than two hours, whichever is less. However, the two-hour restriction may be extended by two hours, if the police department and fire department are notified prior to the expiration of the initial two-hour period or if the vehicle is parked pursuant to work being done under a Village building permit.

(c) If a driver or operator of the truck should be unable to move the vehicle due to mechanical problems, the driver or operator shall, as soon as possible, notify the police department and fire

department and advise such agency of the location and cargo of the vehicle.

(d) Any person violating any provisions of this section or resisting the enforcement of this section shall, upon conviction, be fined not more than \$100 as provided in section 1-16 for each offense. Each day such violation shall continue shall constitute a separate offense.

Section 3. Those provisions of the Village Code that have not been expressly amended herein remain in full force and effect.

Section 4. If any section, paragraph, clause or provision of this Ordinance shall be held invalid, the invalidity thereof shall not affect any other provision of this Ordinance.


Section 5. All Ordinances, resolutions, motions or orders in conflict with this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

Section 6. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon its passage, approval and publication as provided by law.


