AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 42-94 (DEPOSIT OF REMOVED SNOW RESTRICTED) OF DIVISION 3 (OBSTRUCTIONS AND ENCROACHMENTS) OF ARTICLE II (USE AND MAINTENANCE) OF CHAPTER 42 (STREETS, SIDEWALKS AND OTHER PUBLIC PLACES) OF THE VILLAGE CODE S IN THE VILLAGE OF CHICAGO RIDGE, COOK COUNTY, ILLINOIS

WHEREAS, the Village of Chicago Ridge, Cook County, Illinois (the “*Village*”) is a home rule unit of local government pursuant to Article VII, Section 6, of the 1970 Illinois Constitution, and, except as limited by such section, it may exercise any power and perform any function pertaining to its government and affairs; and

WHEREAS, the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Chicago Ridge (the “*Corporate Authorities*”) may from time to time amend the text of the Village Code when it is determined to be in the best interests of the residents of the Village; and

WHEREAS, the Corporate Authorities wish to amend the Village Code provisions regarding snow removal; and

WHEREAS the Corporate Authorities find that the above-mentioned amendments are important to protecting the health, safety and welfare of Village residents; and

WHEREAS, the Corporate Authorities find it in the best interests of the Village to amend the Village Code provisions regarding snow removal as further provided below.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Chicago Ridge, Cook County, Illinois, as follows:

Section 1. That the above recital is found to be true and correct and is hereby incorporated herein and made a part hereof, as if fully set forth in its entirety.

Section 2. Section 42-94 (DEPOSIT OF REMOVED SNOW RESTRICTED) of Division 3 (OBSTRUCTIONS AND ENCROACHMENTS) of Article II (USE AND MAINTENANCE) of Chapter 42 (STREETS, SIDEWALKS AND OTHER PUBLIC PLACES) the Village Code is hereby amended by adding the underlined language to provide as follows:

Sec. 42-94. – Snow removal required; Deposit of removed snow restricted.

(A) No commercial or multifamily residential establishment shall deposit upon the property of any adjoining property owners or any public sidewalks any snow removed from its parking lots or adjacent property. In addition, no individual shall deposit snow in excess of three feet in height within 20 feet in any direction of the apex of any corner of an intersection. Further, no person shall pile or deposit snow within three feet in any direction of any fire hydrant.

(B) Every owner, lessee, tenant, occupant or other person having charge of any business premises in the Village, including a building or lot utilized for business purposes, abutting upon any public way or public place, and every owner, agent or manager of a rental dwelling shall utilize their best efforts to remove snow and ice from the sidewalk in front of such business premises, or rental dwelling sidewalk and parking facility, as quickly as possible on the day on which said precipitation falls or by ten o'clock (10:00) A.M. on the day following an ongoing snow or ice event.

(C) In case the snow and ice on the sidewalk, or parking facility ancillary to the use by a rental dwelling, shall be frozen so hard that they cannot be removed without injury to the pavement, the person having charge of any building premises, or rental dwelling, as aforesaid shall

cause the sidewalk abutting the said premises, to be strewn with ashes, sand, sawdust, salt or some similar suitable material and shall, as soon thereafter as the weather shall permit, thoroughly clean said sidewalk.


Section 3. Those provisions of the Village Code that have not been expressly amended herein shall remain in full force and effect.

Section 4. If any section, paragraph, clause or provision of this Ordinance shall be held invalid, the invalidity thereof shall not affect any other provision of this Ordinance.


Section 5. All Ordinances, resolutions, motions or orders in conflict with this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.
