ORDINANCE TO AMEND ST. TAMMANY PARISH CODE OF ORDINANCES, APPENDIX B - PARISH PERSONNEL POLICIES ORDINANCE, SECTION 4.10 HOLIDAYS, TO ADD JUNETEENTH DAY AS A LEGALLY OBSERVED HOLIDAY.

WHEREAS, Juneteenth National Freedom Day is celebrated in remembrance of June 19, 1865, when Union soldiers arrived in Galveston, Texas with news that the Civil War was over and that the Emancipation Proclamation declared an end to slavery in the former Confederate States; and

WHEREAS, in 1997, the 105th United States Congress recognized Juneteenth as the Independence Day Observance of Americans of African Descent; and

WHEREAS, Act 128 of the 2021 Louisiana Legislative Session declared Juneteenth Day as a permanent holiday in Louisiana; and

WHEREAS, by proclamation of Governor John Bel Edwards on June 19, 2021, Juneteenth was recognized as a legal state holiday to celebrate and honor the significant contributions of African Americans in our state, across our nation, and throughout the world; and

WHEREAS, St. Tammany Parish commemorates the achievements of African Americans in our community and honors the strength and resolve of African Americans throughout history by celebrating Juneteenth Day as a legal holiday to be observed on the Friday before the third Saturday of June.

THE PARISH OF ST. TAMMANY HEREBY ORDAINS: that St. Tammany Parish Code of Ordinances, Appendix B - Parish Personnel Policies Ordinance, Section 4.10 Holiday, be amended to add Juneteenth as a legal holiday to be observed on the Friday before the third Saturday of June as such:

REPEAL: All ordinances or parts of Ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

SEVERABILITY: If any provision of this Ordinance shall be held to be invalid, such invalidity shall not affect other provisions herein which can be given effect without the invalid provision and to this end the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby declared to be severable.

EFFECTIVE DATE: This Ordinance shall become effective fifteen (15) days after adoption.



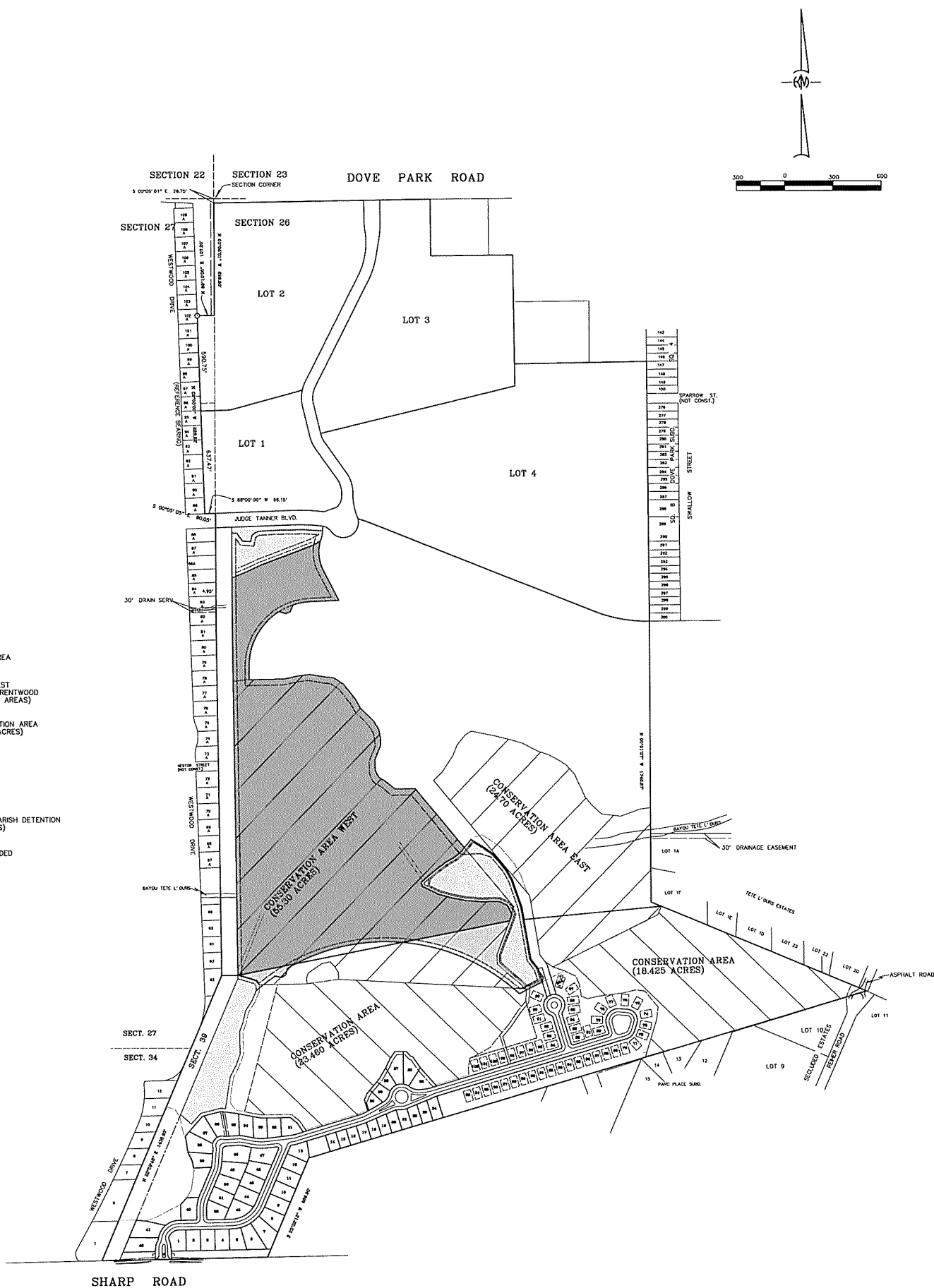

Ordinance Administrative Comment

ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE PARISH OF ST. TAMMANY, THROUGH THE OFFICE OF THE PARISH PRESIDENT, TO ACQUIRE PROPERTY FOR THE WESTWOOD REGIONAL DETENTION POND PROJECT AND TO RELEASE SUCH PROPERTY FROM MOST HOLY TRINITY CONSERVATION AREA (WARD 4, DISTRICT 5)

Most of the property identified as needed for the Westwood Regional Detention Pond is presently encumbered by the Most Holy Trinity Conservation Area by agreement with the Archdiocese and Brentwood Estates as conditions to their respective developments. Now that Parish has identified the Pond areas, it is now appropriate to proceed with full acquisition of the property needed for the Pond. Full acquisition will include an amendment to the Conservation Area to remove that portion of Pond property within the Conservation Area in order to allow the Pond project to proceed.
