AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ARTICLE I, PARAGRAPH "CONNECTION", OF ORDINANCE NO. 115, WATER ORDINANCE, OF THE CITY OF EARLVILLE, ILLINOIS

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF EARLVILLE, ILLINOIS:

That Article I, Paragraph "CONNECTION," of Ordinance No. 115 of the City of Earlville, Illinois, be amended to read as follows:

CONNECTION. No connection with a water main shall be made without a permit being issued and twenty-four hours notice having been given to the superintendent of Water Works. All such connections shall be made under the supervision of the Superintendent, and no connections shall be covered until the work has been inspected by him.

The service pipe from main to curb, the cocks, shut-off box and meter shall be furnished by the applicant or owner and upon the installation thereof shall become the property of the City and shall be maintained thereafter by the City, which meter shall conform to the specifications approved from time to time by ordinance and a copy of such specifications shall be kept in the office of the City Clerk for examination by the persons interested therein. The applicant or owner shall pay for all digging and installation of the above meters and all other meters necessary for such installation. Applications for such connections shall be made to the City Clerk and a fee of \$35.00 shall be paid for tapping the main.
